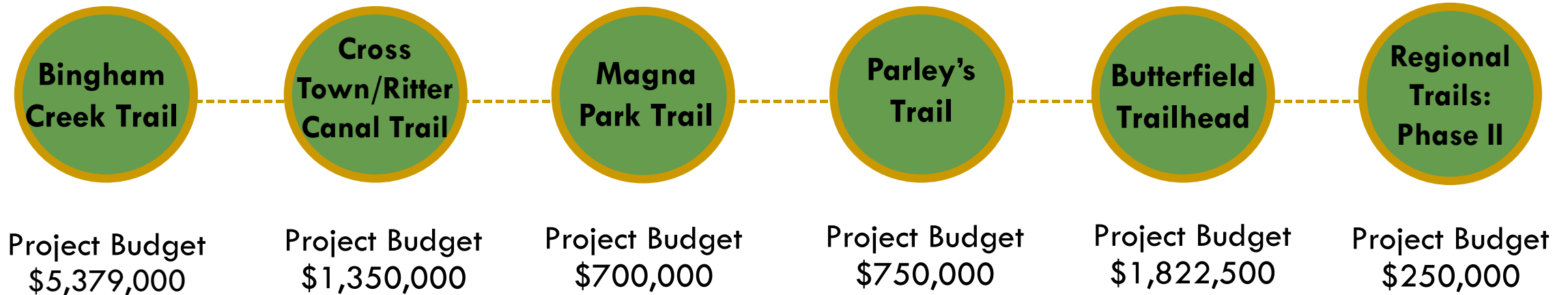
PROJECT HISTORY

In 2019, a Regional Trails Master Plan was prepared which identified a regional network of trails throughout Salt Lake County. These trails connected major destinations, open space, parks, and other municipal trail systems.

In 2022, \$10,251,500 was appropriated from the 4th Quarter Transportation Funds to prepare trail designs, and to construct four regional trails and one major trailhead in Butterfield Canyon.

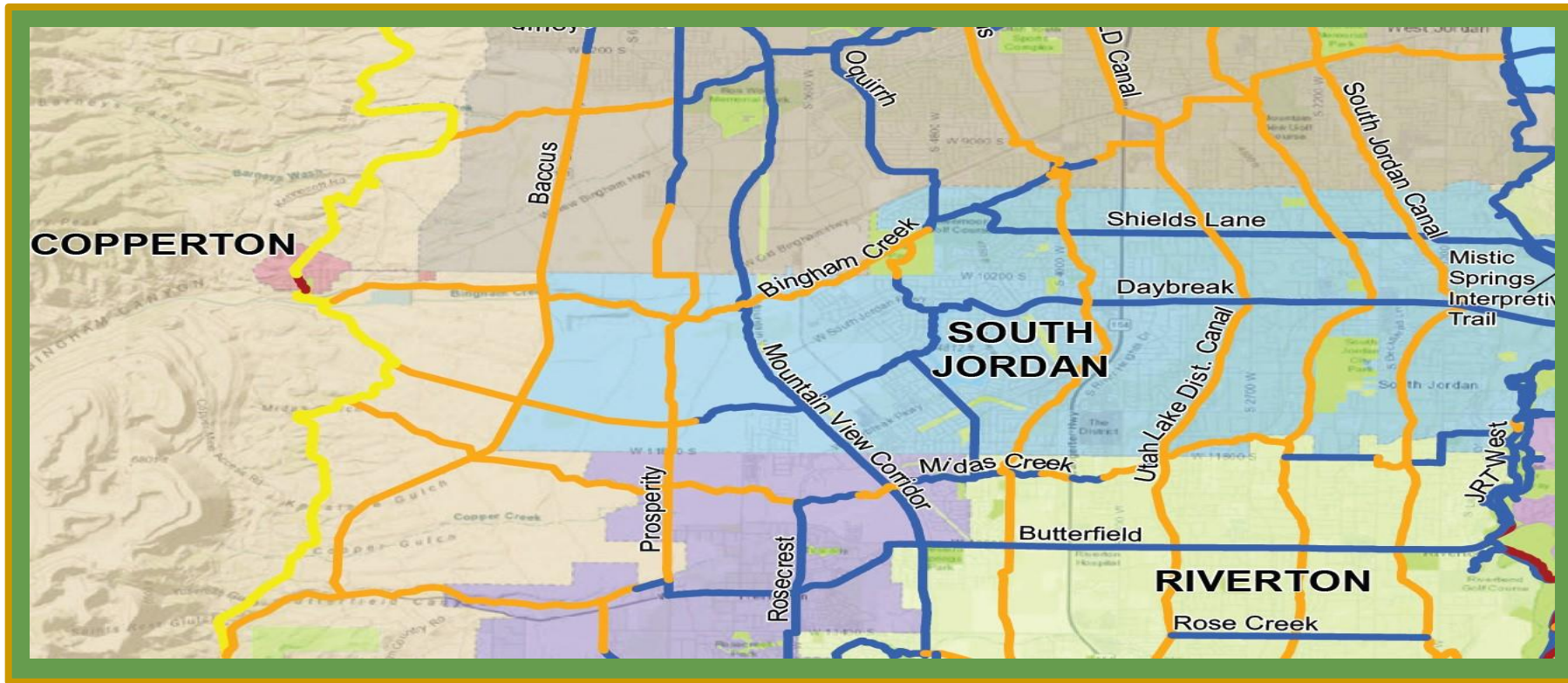
Additionally, \$1,000,000 was appropriated for ongoing trail maintenance and operations.

TOTAL: \$10,251,500



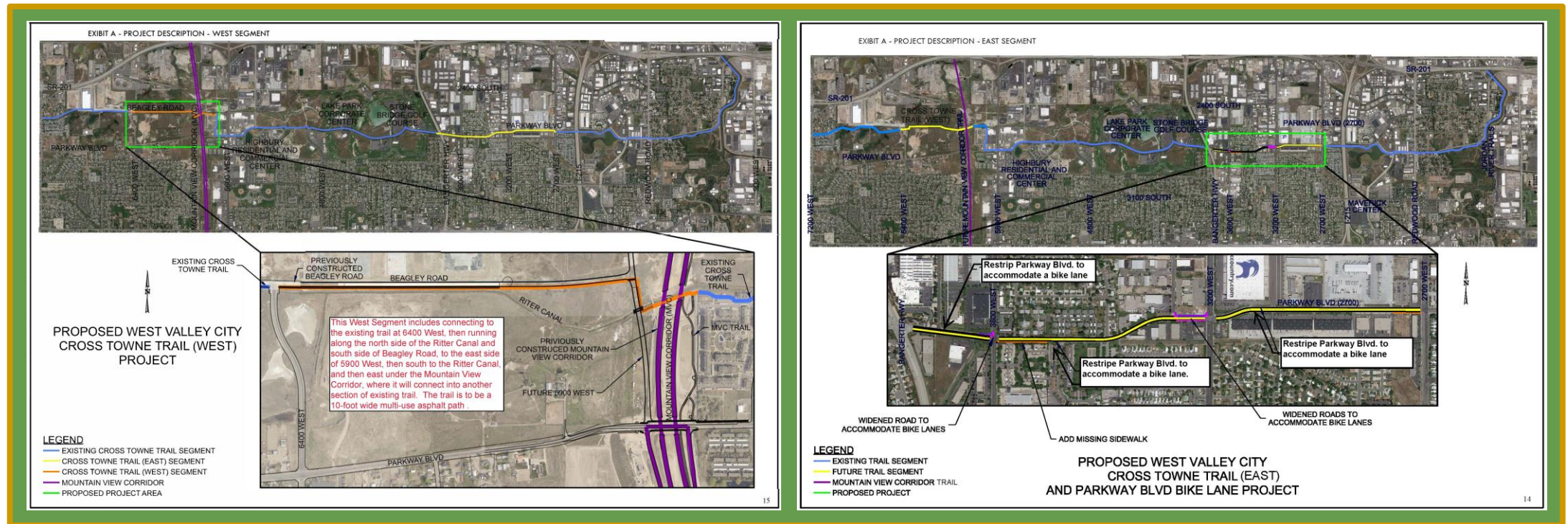
BINGHAM CREEK TRAIL:

- ROADWAY & TRAIL DESIGN: MARCH–OCTOBER 2023
- BIDDING/CONTRACTING: NOVEMBER–DECEMBER 2023
- ROADWAY & TRAIL CONSTRUCTION: MARCH 2024–OCTOBER 2024

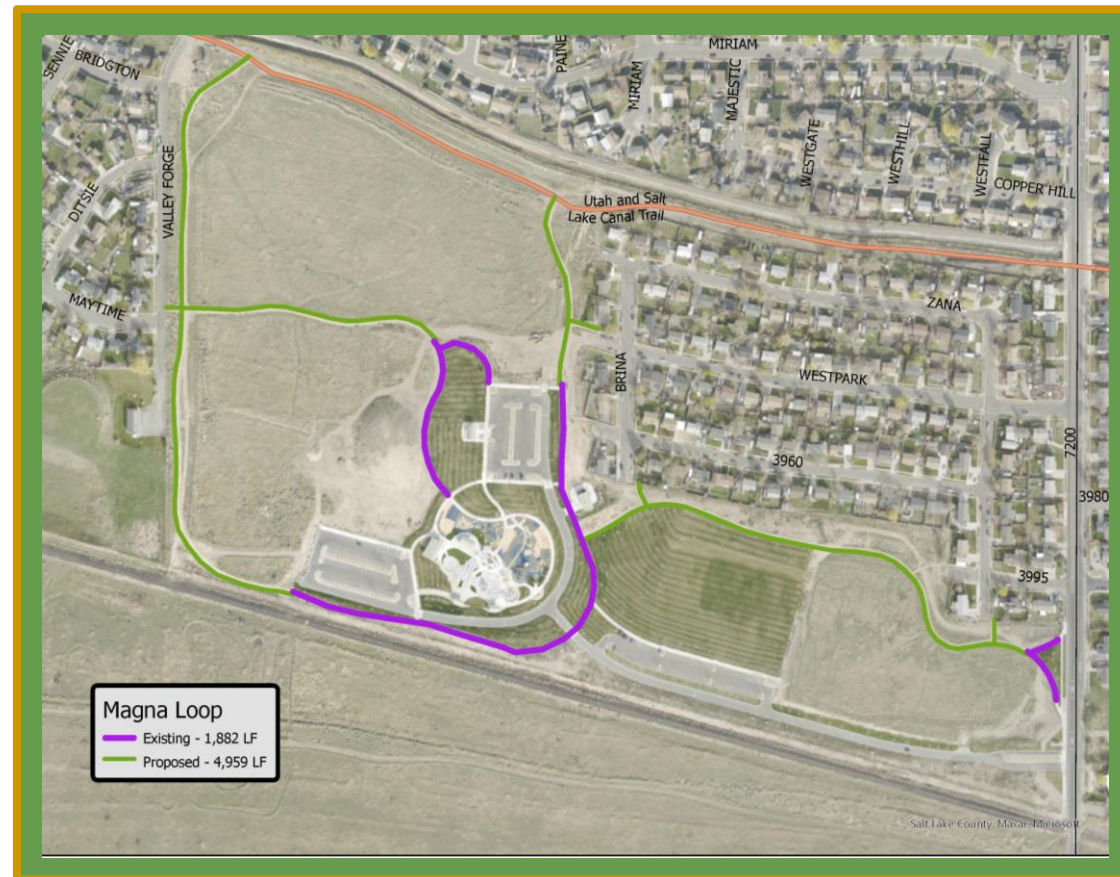


6400 W ← Mountain View Corridor

Bangerter Highway ← 2700 W

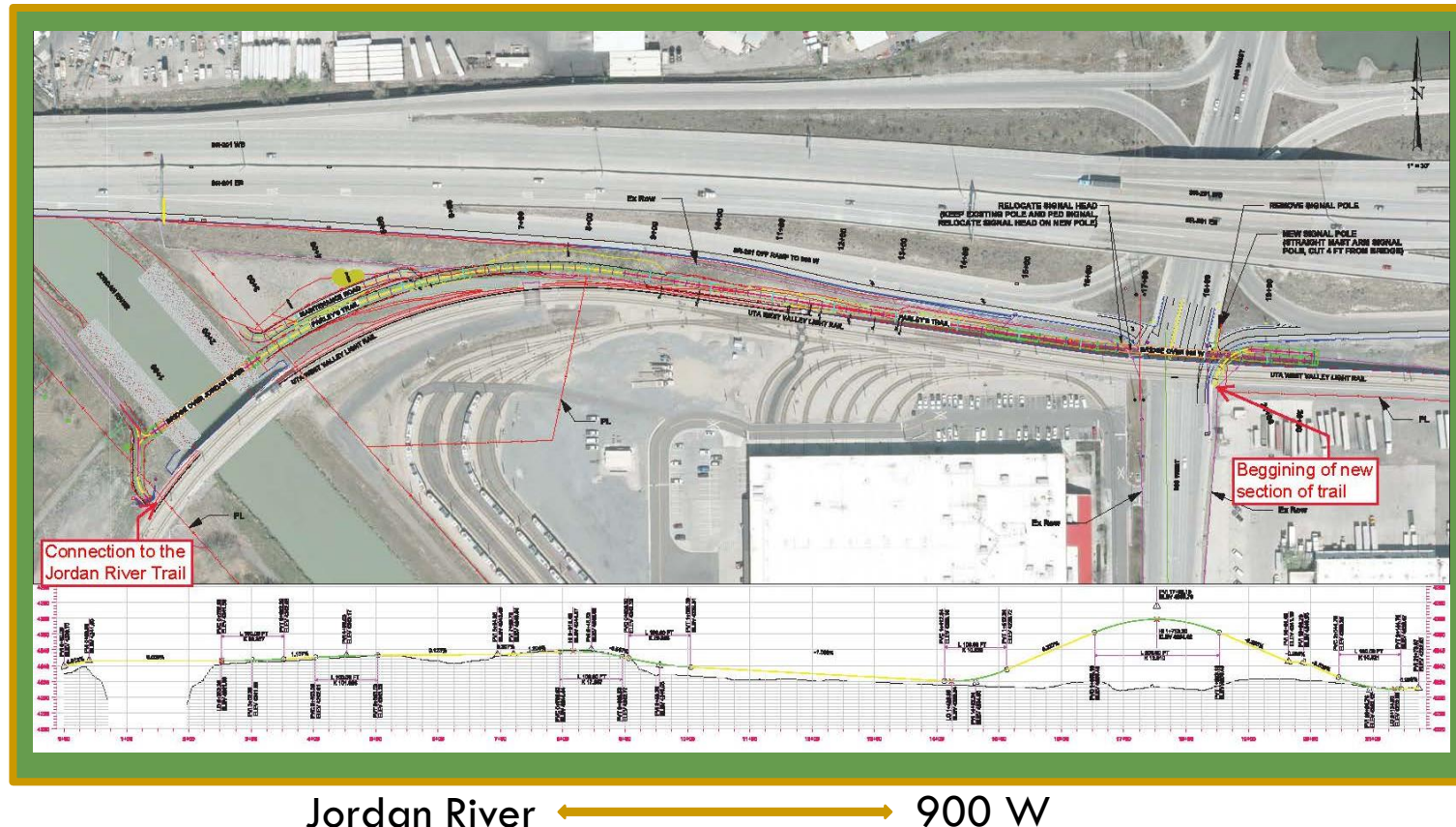
MAGNA REGIONAL PARK LOOP TRAIL:

PARLEY'S REGIONAL TRAIL:

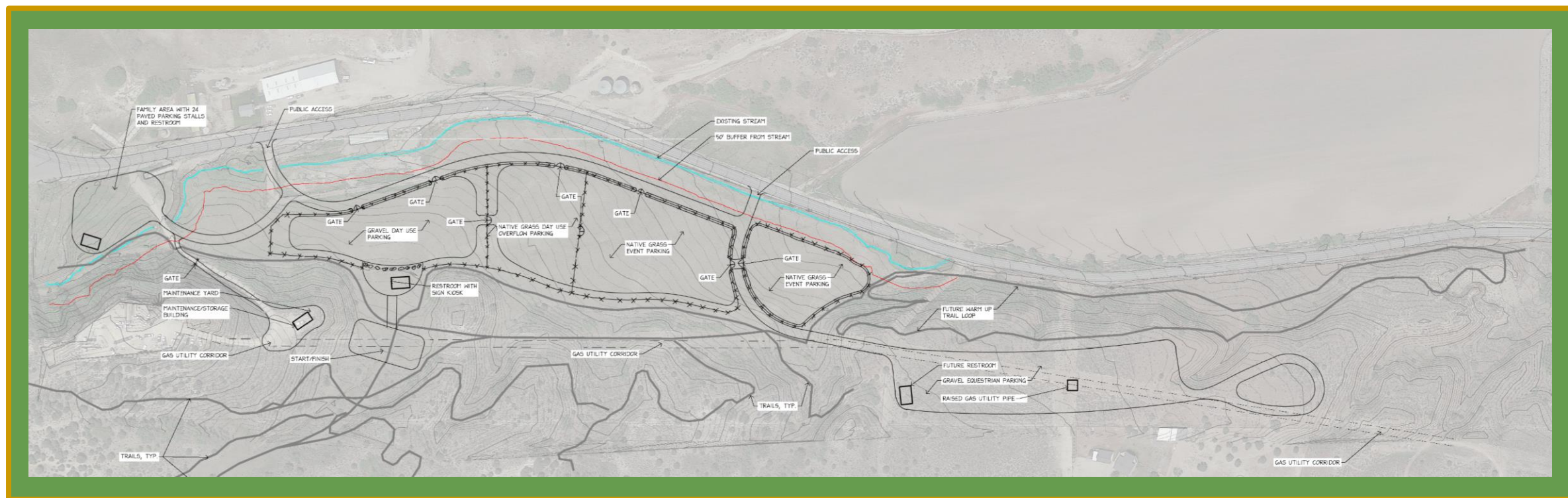
- CONSTRUCTION STARTED: JUNE 2022

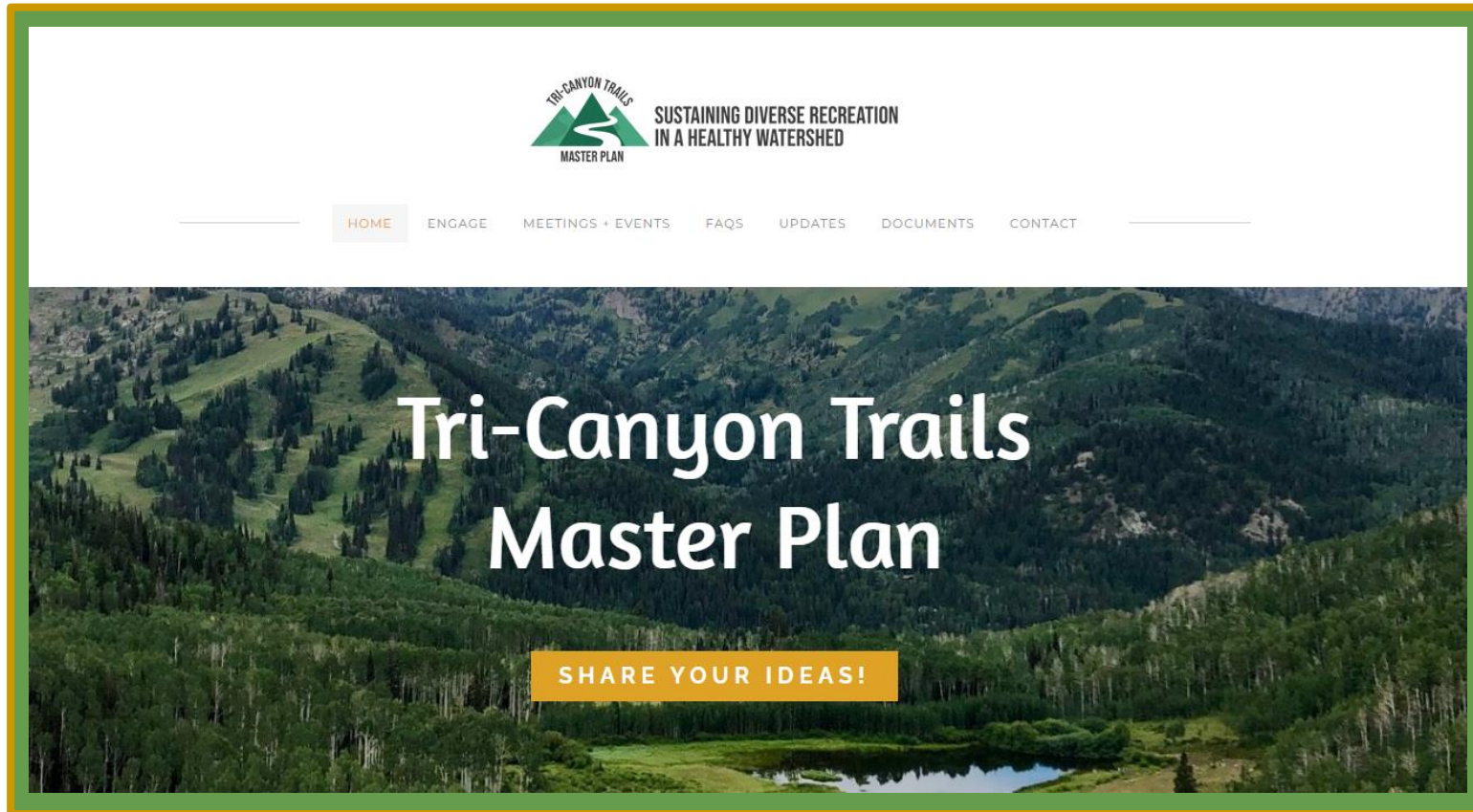
