Dear Mr. Jensen,

This purpose of this letter of agreement is to inform you that Salt Lake County Regional Planning and Transportation intends to provide, on a post-performance reimbursement basis, the following amounts from the 2020 Regional Transportation Choice funds (4th Quarter) to Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation for the following projects:

Annual Trail Maintenance \$ 1,000,000 Phase 2 SLCo Regional Trails Master Plan \$ 250,000 Multiple Trail Designs and Constructions \$10,001,500 (Project List Attached)

Total Amount

\$11,251,500

A list of these projects and the descriptions is attached to this letter. Disbursement of these funds is contingent on the funds being used consistent with the specific project descriptions and Utah State Code 59-12- 2212.2 *Allowable uses of local option sales and use tax revenue*. In addition, the trail design and construction project funds will be disbursed through a reimbursement request accompanied by invoices, proof of payment and completion of the project. Until each project has been completed and the funds have been fully disbursed a biannual status update for the projects shall be submitted to Regional Planning and Transportation on June 30th and December 31st each year. If any project does not require the full amount of funding to be completed, the funds need to be returned to Regional Planning and Transportation immediately. Funds designated for a project shall not be used for another project without prior approval of Regional Planning and Transportation.

The Office of Regional Development hopes these projects will be completed on or before December 31, 2024. If you and your department desire to accept the above listed funds for the purposes stated herein and agree to make a good faith effort to complete the project on or before December 31, 2024. The Magna Regional Park has a trail loop that has been graded and ready to pave. Paving the trail loop inside the park and making bridge connections to the canal trail remains unfinished. The Utah Salt Lake Canal Trail received State Funding through UDOT (3.2 Million) for Phases 5-9.

The last phase of the Parley's Trail is out to bid. Bid opens on November 17. The Engineers bid estimates the bids will come in close to the project budget leaving a shortage of funds for construction contingency.

The MSD is working with Rio Tinto to determine the Ritter Trail Alignment along the canal.

The Bingham Creek Regional Trail will connect Bingham Regional Park to the Mountain View Corridor Trail. Additionally, this trail will link to two UTA Light Rail Stations. Daybreak has worked out a trail alignment from the Bingham Regional Park to the Mountain View Corridor.
