RE: Request by Eye Care 4 Kids to grant a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2017 tax year on parcel 22-19-353-032 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on November 15, 2018 considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2017 tax year on the above mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In October 2018, the District Attorney's office determined that the applicant's request for a charitable exemption be extended to a 100% exemption from a previously granted 86% exemption for 2017. The Board of Equalization granted a 100% exemption on this parcel for 2018. The increase for the 2017 tax year was referred to the Property Tax Committee for review.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for an increase in the charitable exemption percentage from 86% to 100% for the 2017 tax year. A refund of approximately \$1,436.01 would be applicable along with any necessary adjustment for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued with the Treasurer's office to determine the final amount to be refunded.
