Based on the recommendation of the Property Tax Committee, the Salt Lake County Council has taken final action on your request for 2020 active duty exemption as follows:

Action	Type of Relief
Deny	Active Duty Exemption

Active Duty Exemption Tax Relief has been denied due to the following: insufficient information submitted to determine 200 days of active duty military service outside Utah in a continuous 365-day period were completed in 2019, and insufficient information submitted to determine if primary residence is in Salt Lake County. Refer to Utah Code 29-2-1901. If you feel the County has improperly denied your request for Active Duty Exemption Tax Relief, you may appeal to the Utah State Tax Commission. The appeal must be filed within 30 days of this notification. The appeal should be filed with Council-Tax Administration, who will forward the appeal to the State Tax Commission.
