We are a DEA-led, multi-agency drug task force that targets the most significant international drug trafficking organizations distributing drugs in Utah's communities.










- ☐ Sinaloa Cartel is primary source of drugs to Utah
- Our investigative focus:
 - Highest level of cartel distribution to effect the greatest local community impact
 - All Districts, regions, and communities in Salt Lake County
 - Valley-wide multi-agency collaboration
 - ATF, FBI, USMS, HIDTA, Metro Gangs, etc.
 - Federal prosecution

Drug Seizure Data (2019 – Present)



- □ 1.82 million fake pills containing fentanyl
 - 90% seized in the last 24 months
- ☐ 4,661 pounds of methamphetamine
- ☐ 771 pounds of cocaine
- ☐ 425 pounds of heroin
- ☐ 968 arrests
- ☐ 240 firearms
- □ \$19.3 million seized assets









Drug Enforcement Activity - Heatmap
