Mr. Chris Harding, Auditor, said he is unaware of any legislation. After speaking with the Tax Commission there are several things we can do to improve. We have asked for the commercial appeals currently taking 30 days to compress down to 10 days.

Mr. Brad Neff, Tax Administrator, stated there is a statute in place that allows 60 days and an additional statute that allows for requesting an extension.
