# COST TRACKING CHANGES FOR FEDERAL FUNDS

- CARES Act CRF (\$203.6M) was received in late April and COVID Recovery Fund 140 was established to track CARES and FEMA eligible expenditures
- Later as additional guidance was received from CARES and FEMA category infrastructure (combination of 4 chartfields) was established to line up with the federal guidance within Fund 140

# PROCESS FOR MOVING COSTS INTO FUND 140 WITH DETAIL CODING

- Goal is to keep Fund 140 clean for reporting and audits from the Federal Government. Before a
  cost goes into the fund it needs to be reviewed for eligibility, proper documentation and correct
  coding.
- Flowchart for ICS213 forms with designated approvers within the Unified Command Structure for items directly related to COVID that are paid directly out of the COVID Recovery Fund 140.
- Other costs within organizations throughout the County that were small enough to be absorbed in their current budgets are tagged with 009EM.
- Those costs will first be funded with other State and Federal grants. The remainder will be
  analyzed for eligibility and proper documentation and will be moved out into the COVID 140 fund.

### CATEGORIES AND RELATED ACTIVITIES

- Emergency Medical Care: Public Clinics, Temporary Medical Facilities, COVID 19 Testing, Emergency Medical Response, Medical Services including disease testing, treatment, diagnosis and transport), Telemedicine
- Public Health and Safety/Threat Management: COVID Communication (PIO, Health Ambassadors, Health Liaisons, environmental health), PPE for worker/staff, Medical Waste, Public Safety Measures, County Facility Disinfection, Non-County Facility Disinfection, Technical Assistance, ECC Operations.
- Public Health Compliance Actions: Food delivery, Jail response costs, Distance Learning, Telework improvements, Homeless services (not high-risk or isolated)
- Medical Sheltering: Quarantine, Isolation, Animal and High-Risk Sheltering, COVID Childcare, First Responder/Staff lodging, Q&I medical, Congregant living planning
- Other COVID-19 Expenses: Admin, etc. (Financial work, contracting, ICS213 documentation, payroll coordination), rescheduling events, aging high-risk expenses, emergency management technical assistance
- **Economic Recovery Support- General:** Unemployment costs, payroll support programs, external entity training (i.e. business and municipalities), technical assistance and support for community, tourism, recreation and cultural services for COVID recovery
