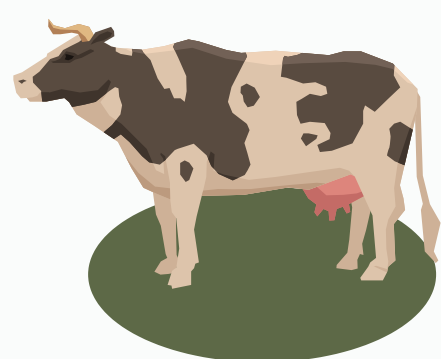
Utah is ranked 2nd in U.S. Tart Cherry Production

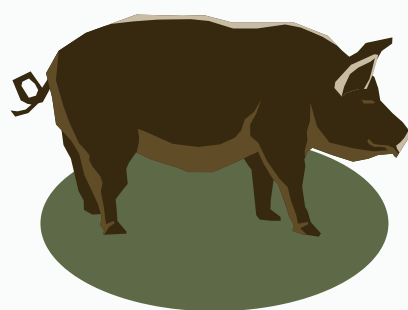

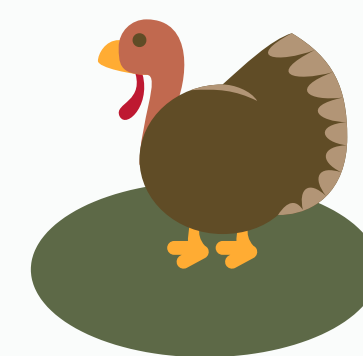

Creates rural jobs

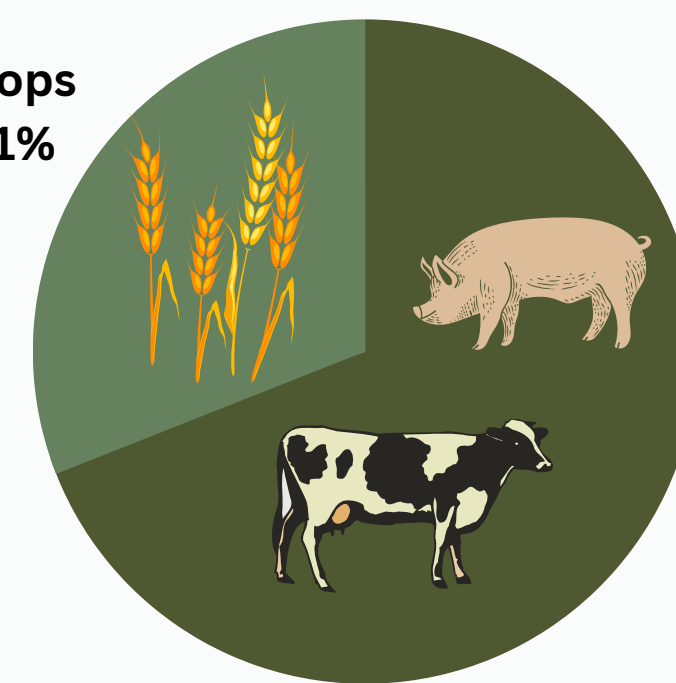
Preserves open space
