Mill Creek Canyon Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) Project

Original Project Budget 2021: \$19,600,000
Current Project Projection 2025: \$29,000,000

☐ June 09, 2020 (Resolution No. 5750) – Initial Payment

\$10,000

Initial payment to initiate the FLAP cooperative project with the Federal Highway Administration-Central Federal Lands Highway Division ("FHWA-CFLHD") and the United States Forest Service ("USFS") to improve access to the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest.

☐ September 28, 2021 (Resolution No. 5899) – Initial Match

\$4,176,200

Salt Lake County Council accepted the FLAP grant for the Upper Millcreek and approved initial funding match requirement for Project Design.

☐ June 4, 2024 (Resolution No. 6205)— Funding Match Modification #1

\$3,863,800

Additional Match requested due to redesigns of some of the project areas and inclusion of additional elements based upon feedback from the public meeting process. Including \$750,000 for RMP utility costs.

☐ January 28, 2025 - Proposed Funding Match Modification #2

\$1,698,200

Additional match requested due contractor project bid for project above estimated project construction costs. Includes \$92,000 for additional RMP utility costs.





Modification Fund Details #2

Office of Outdoor Recreation Grant

\$750,000

Allowable Funding Match Source. SLCo has received 75% or \$562,500 and is included in the 2025 budget. The remaining \$187,000 will be available when the project is completed.

Outdoor Recreation Initiative (ORI) Grant

\$500,000

Allowable funding match source. SLCo has signed the grant agreement and will bill 75% or \$375,000 of the grant as the project moves forward. The remaining \$125,000 will be available after the project is completed.

☐ HB 420 2015 Transportation Program Fund balance

\$356.200

Allowable funding match source. Remaining funds to be allocated from department 1034 "HB 420 2015 Transportation Program" – 2015 legislation
