The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on January 16, 2025, considered a request to reinstate 2024 veteran exemption due to the sale of the property or other change in ownership, after the lien date. The Committee recommends that the following relief be granted:

Veteran Exemption Tax Relief has been denied due to the following: 2024 veteran exemption has already been reapplied to the parcel per veteran claimant's request. If you feel the County has improperly denied your request for Veteran's Exemption Tax Relief, you may appeal to the Utah State Tax Commission. The appeal must be filed within 30 days of this notification. The appeal should be filed with Council-Tax Administration, who will forward the appeal to the State Tax Commission.
