RE: Request by the Corporation of the Presiding Bishop of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints to grant a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2017 tax year on parcels 27-31-200-064 and 27-31-200-065. (Recommend grant) **AMENDED**

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on May 17, 2018 considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2017 tax year on the above mentioned parcels. The committee recommends the request be granted.

The 2018 tax year was approved by the District Attorney's office and the 2017 request was referred to the Property Tax Committee.

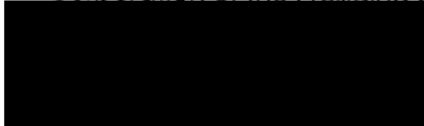
Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends that the Claimant's request for a property tax exemption as a religious organization be granted for the 2017 tax year, with a proration from the purchase date of November 20, 2017 to December 31, 2017. Due to prior exemption status of the seller of these two parcels, and a granted prorated exemption to the Claimant, both parcels are fully exempt and any payment made for the 2017 tax year should be refunded.
