RE: Request by South Mountain Community Church to grant a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2018 tax year on parcel 27-30-200-017 (Recommend grant)

## Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on June 18, 2020, considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2018 tax year on the above mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In April 2020, the Board of Equalization made the determination that the applicant qualified for a religious exemption beginning January 1, 2019. The request for the 2018 tax year was referred to the Property Tax Committee for consideration.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the request be granted. A refund of \$4,099.32 is applicable with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued with the Treasurer's office to determine the final amount to be refunded.
