

Ordinance Revision Legislative Intent

It is the legislative intent of the Salt Lake County Council to conduct a regular, systematic review of existing Salt Lake County Ordinance and Countywide Policies. The purpose of this review is to better align ordinance and policy with the current functions and future aspirations of County government. As a part of this review, the Council proposes the following:

- At least monthly, the Council will dedicate time at its Council Work Session meetings for the legislative consideration of updates and revisions to County Ordinance and Policy.
- The Council will select sections of County Ordinance or Policy for review and discussion, and provide direction to Council staff, the District Attorney's office, and other necessary and appropriate County stakeholders.
- Council staff and the District Attorney's office should prepare revisions to County Ordinance and Policy consistent with Council direction for future legislative consideration and action.
- County departments and offices, as well as independent elected officials, are encouraged to recommend matters for Council consideration through the Mayor's steering committee process.
