Sheriff,

I wanted to follow-up on the pharmaceutical donation that was offered by Otsuka America Pharmaceuticals.

The gift being offered is up to 120 Abilify injections. The retail value of each injection is \$2,156.69. The total value of the donation is (up to) \$258,802.80.

The donation is good through January 2018 through December 2018.

The donated pharmaceuticals is for prisoners housed in the Salt Lake County Jail and to be used on an as needed basis and as prescribed by Health Services prescribers.

In speaking with Richard Bell, this is a drug that we do use, although he is not sure we would use all 120 annually. There would be a benefit for prisoners who were already t If the donation is approved, the supply of Abilify will be replenished as needed (not all 120 doses would be on hand at the jail).

Richard Bell's research uncovered that the pharmaceutical companies were contacted by the Valley Behavioral Health Director with concerns about continuity of care with patients in jail using their medications. The patients who were in jail were able to continue treatment with the use of the donated pharmaceuticals.

Lannie Chapman felt the donation could be considered "sampling," which drug companies do regularly. She is going to do more research on the subject so we are consistent. In the meantime, I recommend we accept the Otsuka prescriptions as a donation. There was not a concern regarding the amount of the donation.

Please let me know if you approve of this donation request or would like additional information. I would be happy to arrange with Carrie to have it placed on the COW agenda.
