Please tell us about yourself.

I traded the political scene of Washington, D.C. for Utah's ski days and red rock deserts when I moved to the mountains in 2017 after graduating with a master's degree in New Media and Photojournalism from George Washington University. I dove into working for the outdoor industry as the Media and Outreach Coordinator for the National Ability Center, a non-profit serving outdoor adaptive recreation programs to people with disabilities. I was in this role through June 2020, feeding my passion for the natural environment through non-profit work until I shifted into the local government sector as a Multicultural Communications and Outreach Specialist for Summit County.

When I'm not in the office, I love spending my time outside riding my mountain bike, hiking with my husband and blind dog (yes, she hikes!), skiing on the weekends with friends, and cooking!

Why are you interested in serving on a board or commission?

Here are two examples of why I am interested in serving on the Local Emergency Planning Committee:

- I began working in the local government sector part time in September 2020, specifically in the Summit County Health Department, during the height of the pandemic doing graphic design, some Spanish translation, video production and social media. By March 2021, I was hired full time. During my first year at the County, I witnessed the importance of organized, cross-departmental, collaborative regional response during times of emergency from public health messaging to administering a mass-vaccination clinic.
- After the Parley's Canyon Fire in 2021, I dove into the creation of emergency response communications plans specifically geared towards sharing information to our Spanish-speaking community.

What education, work experience, or volunteer experience do you have that applies to the board you are applying for?

- I am currently the Multicultural Communications and Outreach Specialist for Summit County, Utah. During my time at Summit County, I have been instrumental in developing and implementing strategic communications plans a visual storytelling techniques in addition to public relations for 13 departments.
- Communicating in multiple languages is imperative during times of emergency: I bring experience in outreach and education initiatives prior to emergencies to communities with a large population of Spanish-speaking residents and workforce members.
- Certifications: FEMA Public Information Basic BLM Wildland Fire Incident Response
- KPCW Radio: Spanish-language advisory board

What unique perspectives could you bring to the board?

I can bring a unique perspective in terms of communicating to people during times of emergency in multiple languages.

After the Parley's Canyon Fire in 2021, Summit County recognized the lack of line of direct communication to our Spanish-speaking residents in times of emergency. Over the past three years, I have played a crucial role in creating a bilingual emergency communications plan for Summit County, implementing the use of and marketing the subscription to NIXLE channels for our Spanish-speaking residents to tune into during times of emergency.

Just last month, we took these initiatives further to establish a WhatsApp channel to communicate with Spanish-speakers in our community. We decided to meet our residents where they already were getting information.
