Deny	Veteran Exemption

Veteran's Exemption Tax Relief has been denied due to the following: applicant has not owned the property at any time during the calendar year which is a requirement per Utah Code 59-2-1904 (2). If you feel the County has improperly denied your request for Veteran's Exemption Tax Relief, you may appeal to the Utah State Tax Commission. The appeal must be filed within 30 days of this notification. The appeal should be filed with Council-Tax Administration, who will forward the appeal to the State Tax Commission. An appeal form is enclosed.
