### FEE WAIVER AMENDMENTS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.42.073, ENTITLED "DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR POWER - FEES," OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, 2001, IS HEREBY AMENDED BY PROVIDING THAT A DIVISION DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION TO WAIVE FEES IS FINALLY DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL, AND MAKING RELATED CHANGES.

The County Legislative Body of Salt Lake County ordains as follows:

SECTION I. The amendments made herein are designated by underlining the new, substituted words. Words being deleted are designated by brackets and interlineations.

SECTION II. Section 3.42.073, entitled "Department director powers—Fees," of the Salt Lake County Code of Ordinances, 2001, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 3.42.073 – [Department director powers -] Fees.

- A. The <u>deputy mayor or</u> department director shall review and approve a schedule of all fees imposed by divisions within the <u>office or</u> department prior to submission to the county council during the budget approval process.
- B. The <u>mayor's office</u> [department director] may <u>recommend that the council</u> waive or adjust fees [, or may designate division directors to waive or adjust fees,] in accordance with the following standards and procedures:
  - 1. A fee imposed by an executive branch department, agency or division may be waived or adjusted by the [department director] recommendation of the mayor's office and approval of the council unless that fee is specifically established by [ordinance or by] state statute or regulation. Fees established by ordinance may

only be waived by the council and fees established by state law may only be waived in accordance with state law.

- 2. Waiver shall be upon good cause shown to contribute to the safety, health, prosperity, moral well-being, peace, order, comfort, or convenience of county residents [and in the public interest]. Any waiver shall be in writing.
- 3. Fees such as late fees or service charges may also be waived, based on the standards and processes established in this ordinance.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof in a newspaper published and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
