Ms. Holder:

We appreciate the opportunity to apply for the BRIC Grant to fund the 2022 BRIC Jordan School District Earthquake Mitigation Scoping Project. We believe this to be an important step forward in making sure our schools are safe for our communities.

Jordan School Districts agrees to pay the 30% local (non-federal) share. This 30% will not come from federal funding sources but will come from Jordan School District's Local Capital Levy proceeds (local property taxes dedicated to facility needs). These funds are already available, as the Board of Education and the administration of Jordan School District believe strongly in this project. We want to understand each school's current situation and earthquake preparedness so we can evaluate our next steps.

As this project will cost \$450,000, we commit to 30% (or \$135,000) from local sources with the remaining \$315,000 coming from the BRIC grant. The project is to do a tier/level 2 assessment on the identified ten schools. As such, the funds will be used to hire experts in this area to perform this assessment.
