Dear Councilmembers,

Salt Lake County Constable Travis J. Reitz has submitted an application and supporting information necessary to appoint John P. Strong to serve as a deputy constable under their authority pursuant to Salt Lake County Ordinance § 2.50.090. I have reviewed the application and it appears to be complete, meeting all necessary requirements of Utah Code and Salt Lake County Ordinance, including a successful background check, proof of POST certification, and deposit of necessary fees to the County's general fund. The full application, including protected information, is on file with the County Council's legal counsel.

Constable Reitz requests the Council's consideration of this appointment, and I am forwarding it to the Council for appropriate action at the Council's April 4, 2023 meetings.

If approved by the Council, John P. Strong would serve as a deputy constable under Constable Reitz's authority for a term of six years, or until the termination of Constable Reitz's term, which is currently set to expire on June 30, 2025.
