RE: Request by Ashley and Mathew Cole to grant a primary residential exemption for the 2021-2022 tax years, and refund overpaid taxes on parcels 22-15-452-028-0000 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on August 15, 2024, considered a request to grant a primary residential exemption for the 2021-2022 tax years on the above-mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

The Claimants have been the owners of the property since 2020 and have requested a retroactive primary residential exemption for the tax years 2021-2022, and provided the necessary verification required to verify that the property has been their primary residence for the years requested.

Based on the available evidence, the Property Tax Committee recommends the request for a residential exemption be granted for the 2021-2022 tax years. A refund of approximately \$25,981.47 is applicable, along with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued with the Treasurer to determine the final amount to be refunded.
