A RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE TRANSFER OF BRUCE FIELD PARK, DAVID GOURLEY PARK,
IMPRESSIONS PARK, LODER PARK, MOUNTAIN MAN PARK, NORTH
PARK, AND SOUTH PARK FROM SALT LAKE COUNTY TO THE METRO
TOWNSHIP OF KEARNS

RECITALS

- A. Salt Lake County (the “County”), owns seven (7) parks commonly known as, Bruce Field Park, David Gourley Park, Impressions Park, Loder Park, Mountain Man Park, North Park, and South Park (hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Parks”), within the metro township of Kearns (“Kearns”), and as more specifically described in the quitclaim deeds (“Quitclaim Deeds”), attached as Exhibits A through G to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
- B. The County desires to formally transfer and convey the Parks to Kearns, and Kearns desires to formally take and receive the Parks from the County, for the purposes and on the terms and conditions set forth in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement and the Quitclaim Deeds.
- C. A public hearing was held on October 4, 2022, at the County Government Center to discuss the transfer of the Parks by Salt Lake County to the Township of Kearns.
- D. It has been determined that the best interests of the County, Kearns and the general public will be served by transferring ownership of the Parks, and by execution of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement and the Quitclaim Deeds attached to this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the transfer of the Parks from the County to Kearns is hereby approved, and the Mayor is authorized and directed to execute the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement and the Quitclaim Deeds attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
