

SLCo Emergency Management Fund Balance Transfer Requests

Updates to Continuity of Operations Plans (COOP) for SLCo Agencies

Summary: SLCo Emergency Management has recommended that every agency within the Salt Lake County government update its COOP plan at least every two years. This program is part of that ongoing strategy.

Timeline: Anticipated completion by second quarter 2023.

Scope:

- Emergency Management team (together with an outside consulting firm) to work with individual agencies in workshop exercises and otherwise to guide agencies through the COOP update process.

Cost: \$262,625

Active Shooter Training Program

Summary: Recent mass shootings across the United States demonstrate the need for all individuals to be able to respond and take emergency protective measures during these tragedies. This program will entail: 1) an awareness-level active threat training for individuals, 2) a training exercise for the SLCo's Policy Group, and 3) an update to the county's current online SABA training for active shooter situations. Training to be provided based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Run. Hide. Fight.® concept. Consultant team to provide training in coordination with SLCo Emergency Management team and SLCo Public Safety Bureau.

Timeline: Anticipated to be completed by second quarter 2023

Scope:

- Individual in-person trainings for employees who work in the Government Center (with anticipated additional "satellite" trainings at other County facilities).
- Policy Group (i.e., Senior Officials within the Salt Lake County Government) interactive and discussion-based exercise to train the Policy Group regarding active shooter leadership response.
- Update to the County's current online SABA training for active shooter situations.

Cost: \$130,000
