

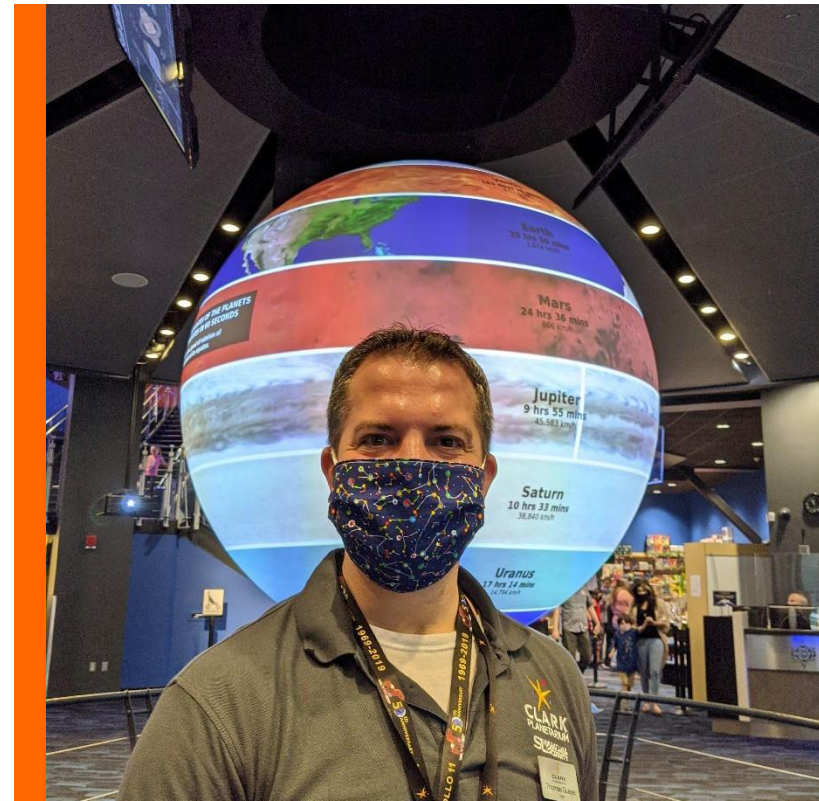

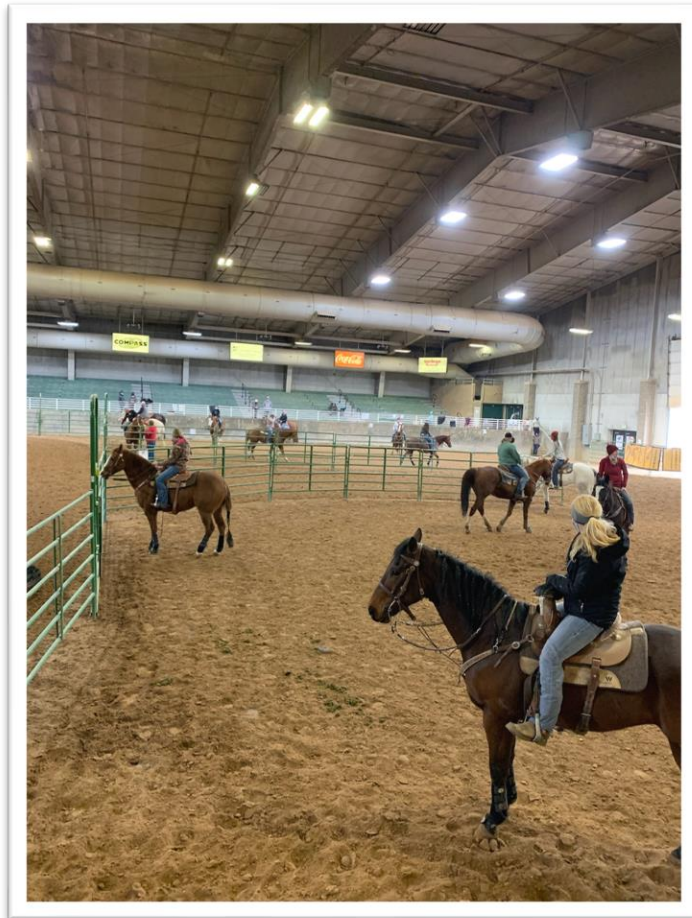

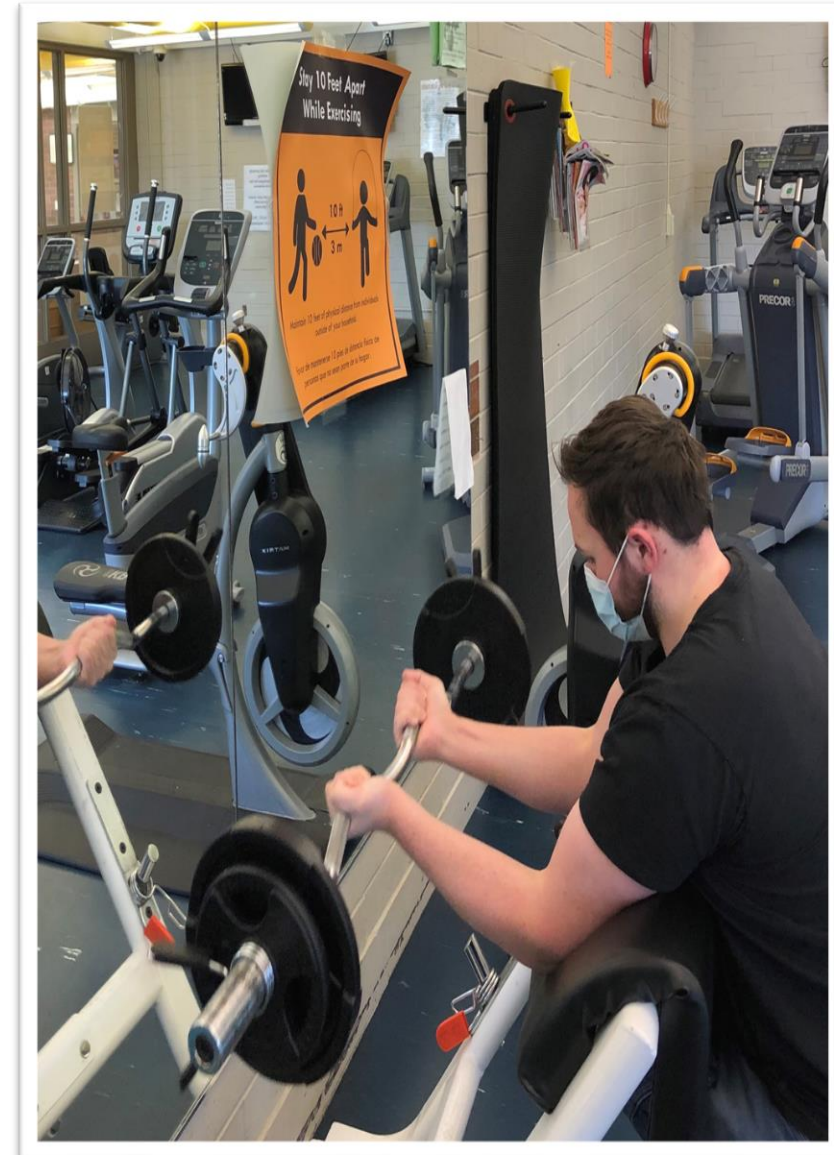
- Reduced capacity that will increase overtime
- Social distancing
- Enhanced cleaning
- Mask mandate
- Meeting state guidelines

- Added virtual programming wherever possible



- Daily boarding and park operations have been ongoing
- Open ride reinstated May 15, 2020
- Expanded programming reinstated in June 2020
- Rolled back some programming based on State of Utah High Transmission status November 2020
- Expanded programming reinstated in February 2021



- Parks have remained open with enhanced cleaning
- Golf courses reopened on April 3, 2020
- Third party sport team field rentals with testing and/or mask requirement beginning March 10, 2021
- Senior softball program on schedule in April with testing and/or mask mandate



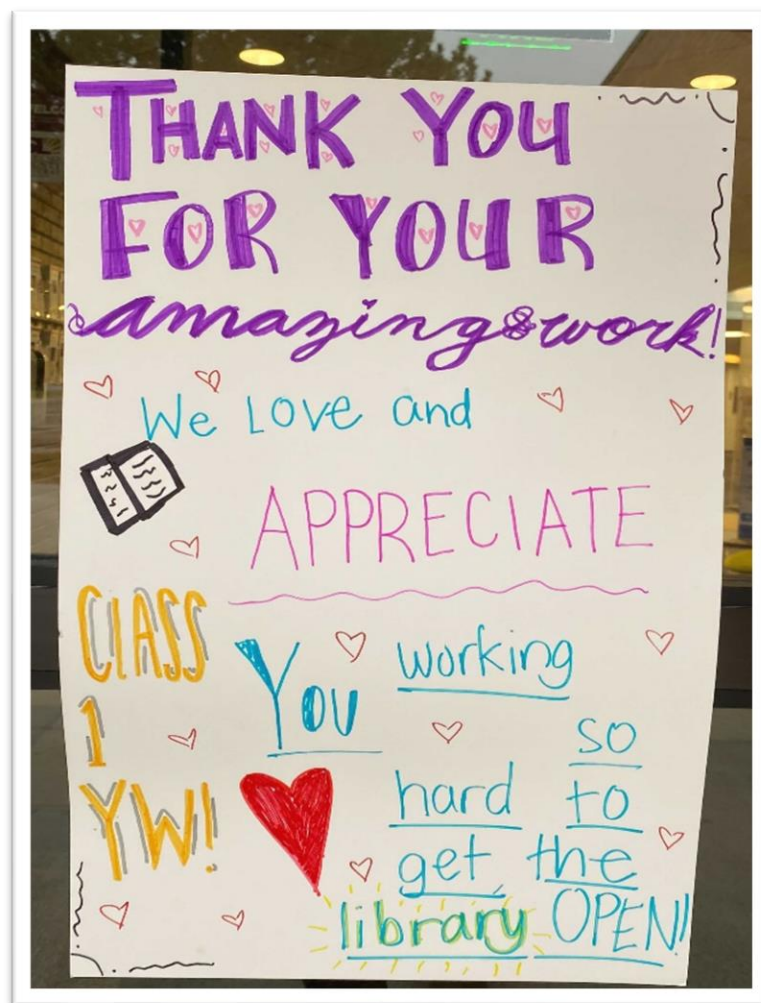
- Reopened recreation facilities on June 1, 2020 and have remained open for individual activities & family member groups
- Rolled back team/group programming based on state of Utah High Transmission status November 2020
- Expanded recreation center programming began on March 1, 2021
- Indoor and outdoor youth sports clinics opens April 1st
- Registration opening in March/April for 2021 for summer camps & programs rolling out in June
- Third party rentals with testing and/or mask requirement March 10th
- High School Club teams follow state of Utah “Test to Play” guidelines

- Reopened venues to resident companies on June 1, 2020
- Opened for public performances September – November 2020
- March 25th reopening with 6ft social distancing.
- Plans to expand seating going forward with mask mandate





- Reopened to the public on June 15 – November 30, 2020
- Reopened on March 1, 2021
- Provided virtual student experiences *~46,000 kids reached
- 4,000 science take and make kits distributed
- 2021 summer camps



- Online resources and customer support have been ongoing
- Virtual programs initiated on March 16, 2020
- Opened curbside services May 26, 2020
- Reopened on July 13, 2020 with limited hours
- Limited computer access and seating
- Limited rentals at the Viridian
- Expanded services and hours beginning April 2021
