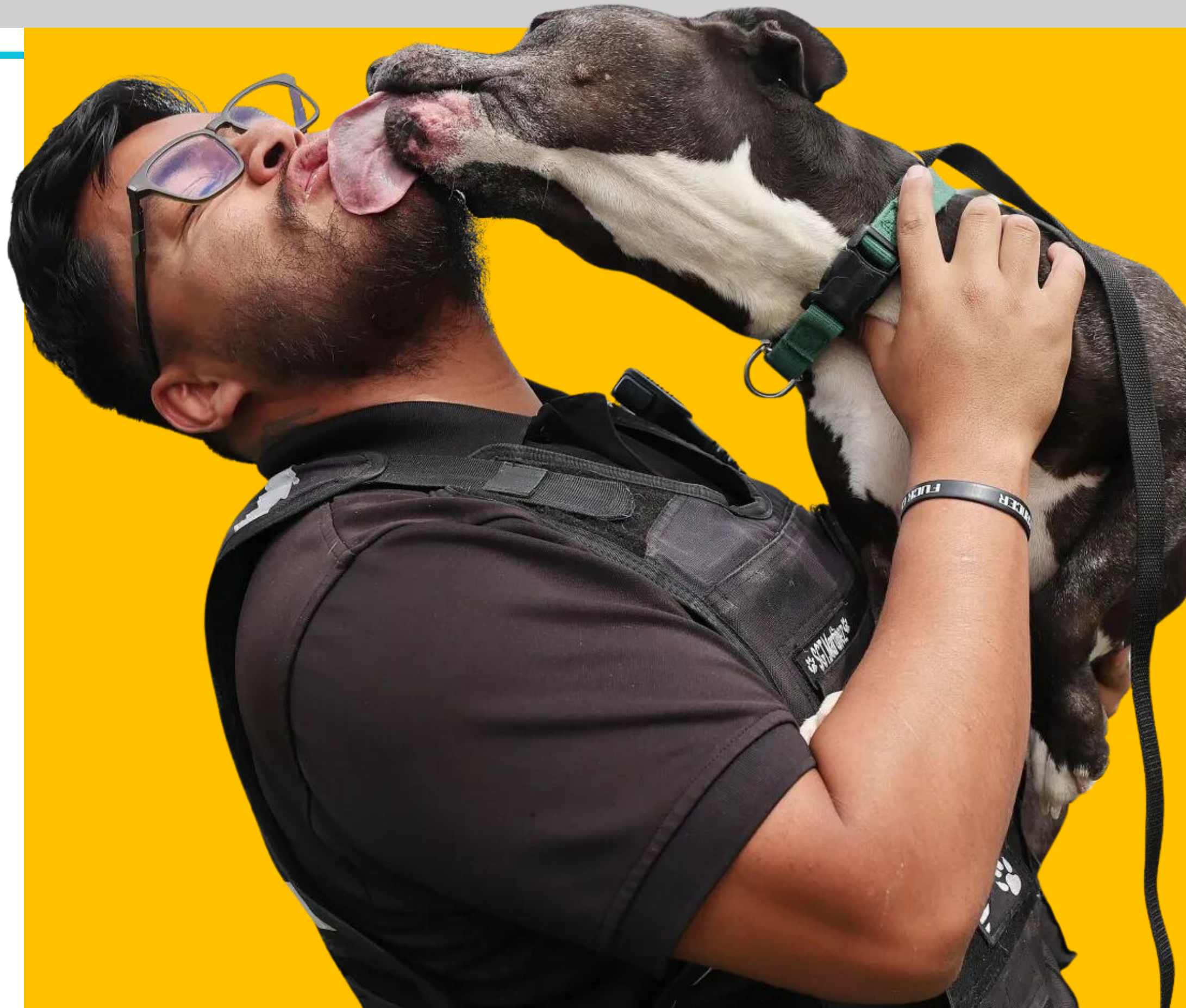

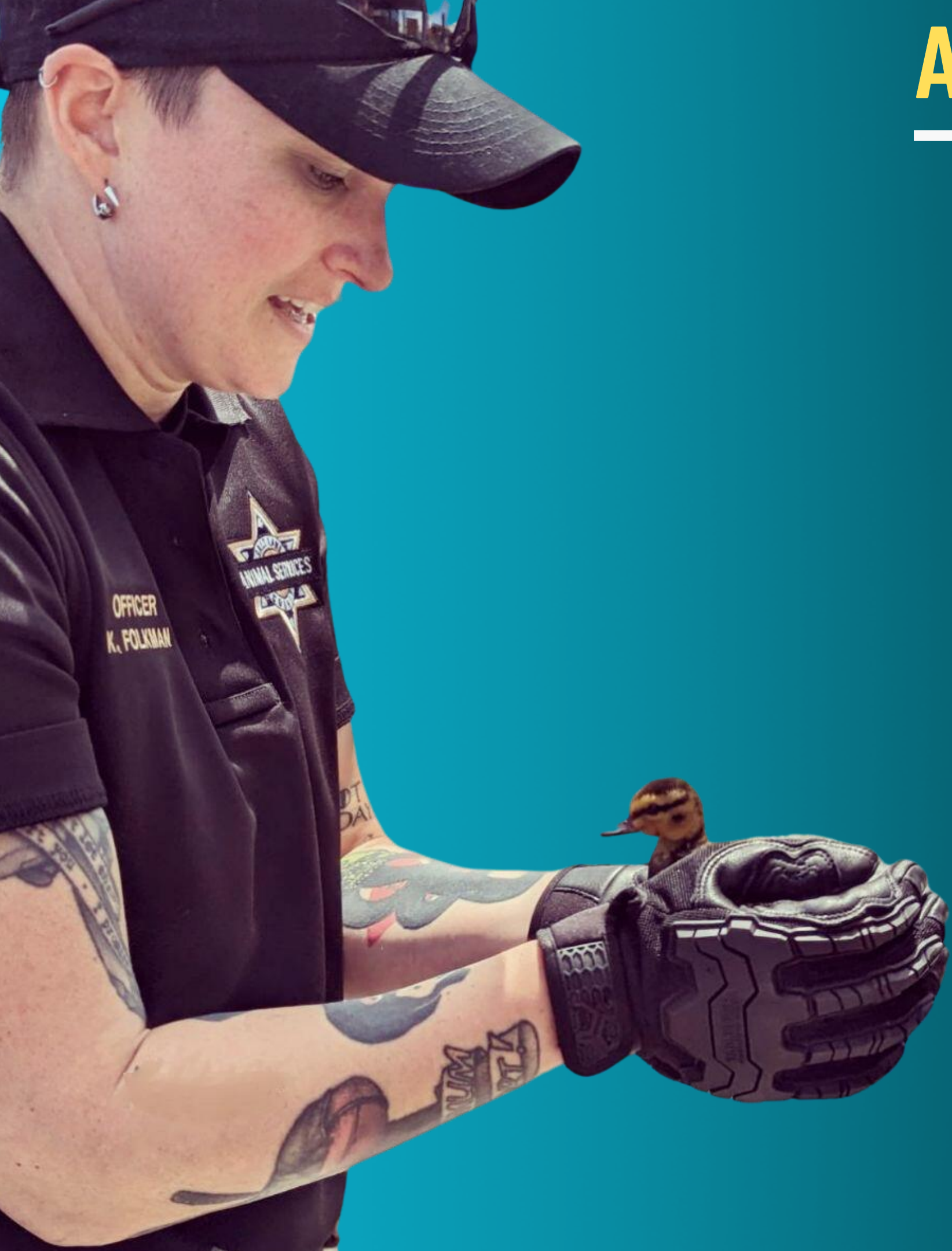

ANIMAL CONTROL TEAM

- 26 expert officers.
- Field resources.

- 24/7 response and urgent care life-saving support.
- Rabies and vaccine clinics.
- Dispatch, radio, connected support.
- Protective custody support.
- ACO Cares Program.

Shelter Teams

Animal Care Team:

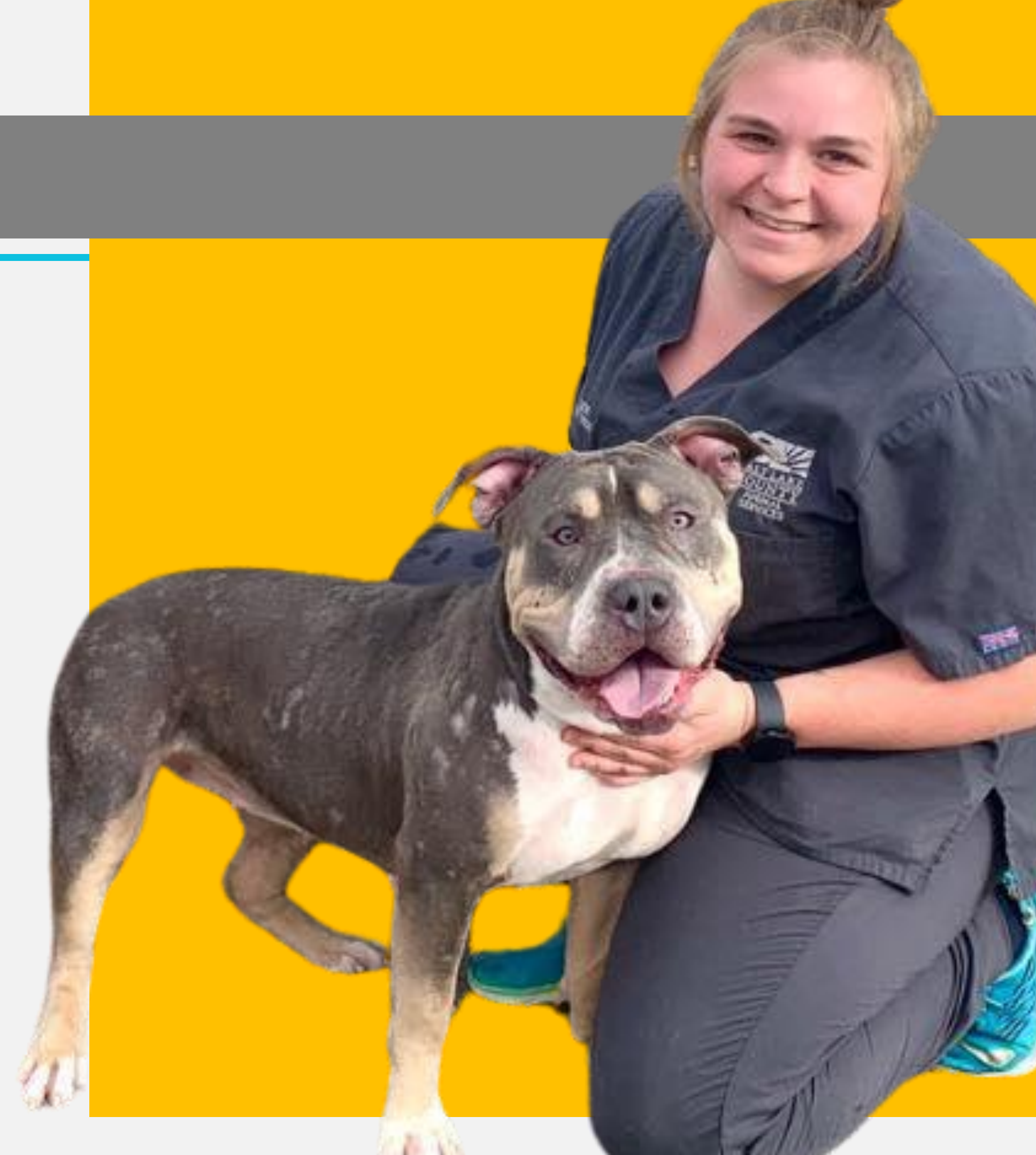
- Care of pets in both shelter locations.
- Enrichment support.
- Behavior and pathway program.

Veterinary Team:

- Veterinary care for shelter pets, emergency care, vaccines, and disease prevention/control.
- Administer rabies to shelter and owned-pets.
- Provide urgent care and pain treatment to pets in need.
- Vaccination of pets on intake into the shelter.
- Sterilization of all pets impounded prior to adoption.

Customer Care Team:

- Licenses pets, processes permits, and reunites lost pets with owners.
- Provides resources for pet owners, registers pets for trainings/surgeries/etc.



ADMINISTRATION

- Employee management: hiring, training, employee relations.
- Ordinance, contract, legislative oversight. Ensure compliance with rabies compendium and state/federal regulations.
- Relationships with local, state, and national partners.
- Responsible for public/media/jurisdiction inquiries and response.
- Cyber-security, financial controls, and records management.
- Responsible for buildings, maintenance, capital projects, audits, expenditures, and program accountability.



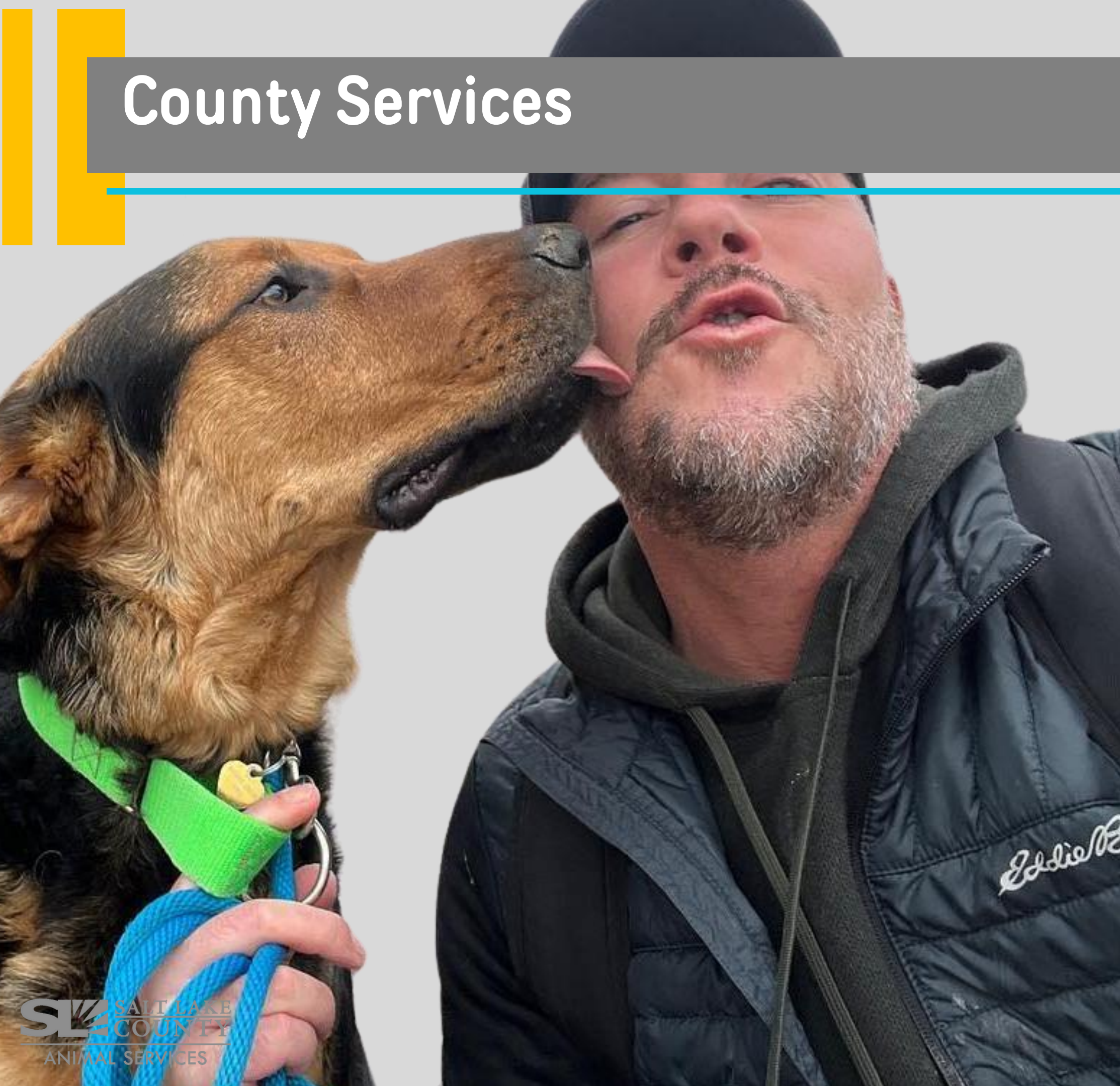

Shelter Intake

- Length of stay & space
- Sterilizations
- Behavior

Community Challenges

- High-density housing (generational, multiple pets/owners)
- Lack of resources (training, socialization, medical treatment)
- Increased use of multi-use public space
- Financial, housing, homelessness crisis

Contra Reduction

- \$51,781 personnel (Development Coordinator Position)
- \$13,638 operations (Spayghetti Event)
 - Total: \$65,419

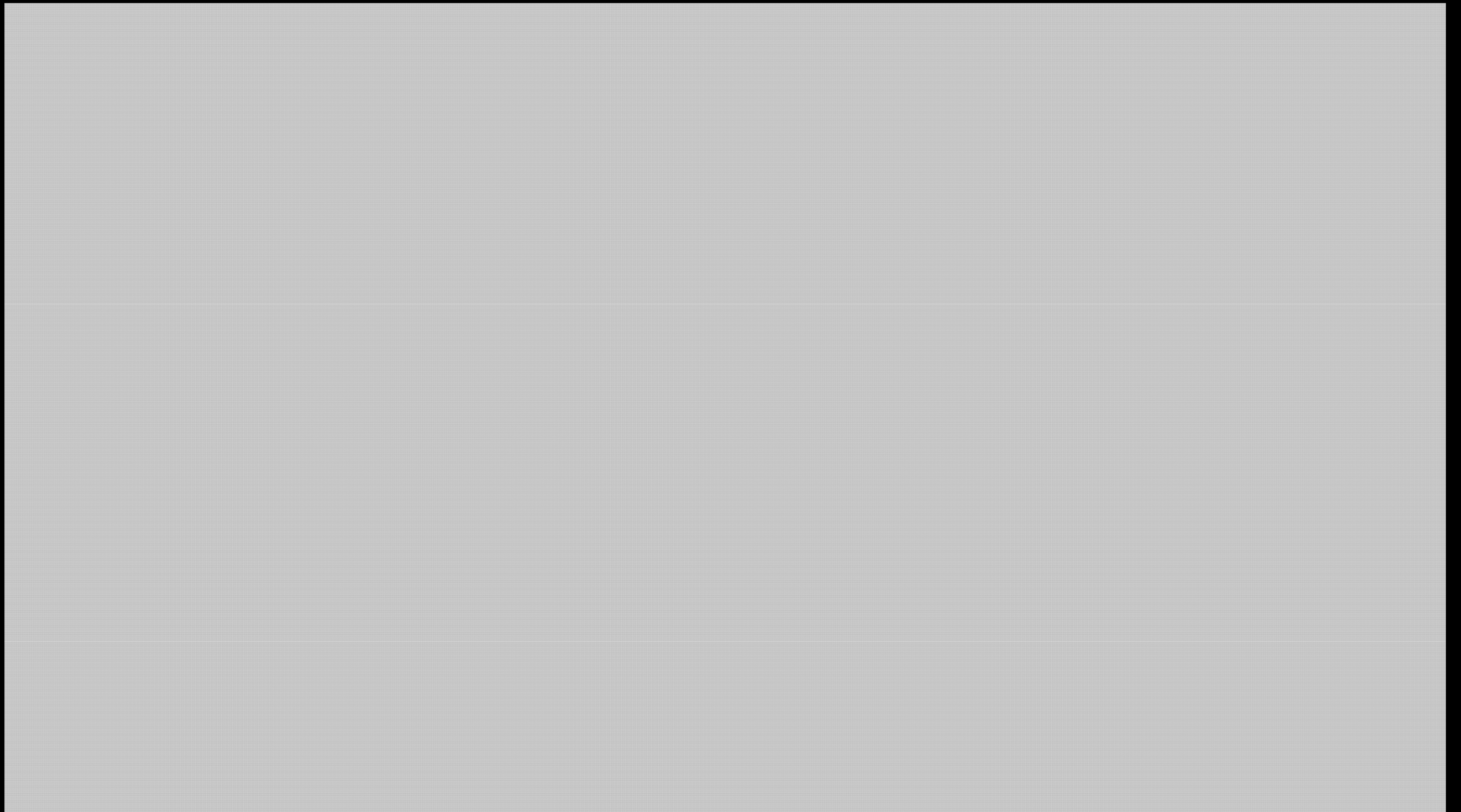
