EFFECTS OF REDUCED STAFFING

The staffing reductions affect our entire operation with the most significant impact being on jail staff and operations. The reductions in personnel affect multiple areas including:

- Health Services
- Jail Facilities
- Jail Support Division (booking, processing, visiting, etc.)

Due to the current staffing levels, we are trending high in overtime. This not only has budgetary implications but also affects operations and job satisfaction

- Operational impacts Delays in efficiently providing all services including how quickly we can book and process individuals into our custody
- Morale and Burnout –"Burnout" has a detrimental effect on an employee's performance, job satisfaction, and overall wellness. This leads to challenges in retention and hiring.
