ABOUT OUR SWORN PAY PLAN

Each bureau/certification in the Sheriff's Office has its own pay structure based on rank within the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office Sworn Pay Plan. Pay for each rank is based on a step and grade structure.

The Public Safety Bureau certification is Special Functions Officer (SFO).

The Corrections Bureau certification is Special Functions Officer & Basic Corrections Officer (SFO/BCO).

2024 CHALLENGES



JAIL JANITORIAL & LAUNDRY SUPPLIES

Due to inflation, the costs of janitorial and laundry supplies continue to increase. We have overspent the budget for this year and last and anticipate overspending without the requested increase to maintain minimum standards of cleanliness. (100,000+10,000=\$110,000)



UTILITIES

Costs of utilities continue to increase overall. Additional costs and fees related to gas, stormwater, and other utilities are being assessed by providers to both the ADC and Oxbow Jails. (145,531+25,152=\$170,683)



RADIO UPGRADES

Due to statewide changes in UCA, our radios need to be upgraded to the P25 so they will work in compliance with statewide system. (\$40,000)



STARLINK

Starlink is a WiFi service that would give Search & Rescue access to use internet and cell phones in remote areas during an operation. (\$2,500)
