**RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
WITH THE UNIFIED FIRE AUTHORITY**

The Legislative Body of Salt Lake County resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Utah State Legislature provided under Utah Code Ann. §§ 11-13-101, et seq., that any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action;

WHEREAS, Salt Lake County (“County”) and Unified Fire Authority (“UFA”) are “public agencies” as defined by the Utah Interlocal Cooperation Act, Utah Code Ann. §§ 11-13-101 *et seq.* (the “Interlocal Act”), and, as such, are authorized by the Interlocal Act to enter into this Agreement to act jointly and cooperatively in a manner that will enable them to make the most efficient use of their resources and powers; and

WHEREAS, UFA has requested a fee waiver for a portion of the Mountain America Exposition Center on April 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15 of 2022. The County Council hereby finds there is good cause shown for the fee waiver as the All-Hazards Incident Management Team Training Academy will contribute to the safety and health of county residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salt Lake County Council that the attached Agreement, Exhibit “A”, between County and the UFA is hereby approved and the Salt Lake County Mayor is authorized to execute the same.
