Re: 2023 Tax Exemptions and Abatements - **CORRECTED**

Due to the last minute tax rate change affecting the tax areas in Bluffdale, the Veteran Exemption total previously reported was incorrect.

For Tax Year 2023, Salt Lake County has allowed exemption and abatement of property taxes as follows:

This compares to 2022 Tax Relief applications (12,909) totaling \$12,680,531.22. 329 more applications in 2023 with an increase of taxes abated \$3,461,049.97
