Indoor Arena Lighting: In 2018, Equestrian Park was approved for an HVAC project in the indoor arena, EP0015. This project was completed under budget. This budget adjustment requests to use fund balance from the HVAC project under-expend for an exigency capital project to repair general lighting in the indoor arena. In Q4 of 2018, we experienced a power bump from the main utility feed that tripped the main breaker to the venue. Since then, general lighting fixtures in the arena have been failing due to ballast problems within the fixtures. Further, these fixtures are approximately 20 years old. Repairing these fixtures is a high priority so we can maintain normal operations. These funds would replace over 24 individual light fixture ballasts. There are two to three ballasts per fixture. This is a one-time request from fund balance.
