RE: Request by Encircle Family and Youth Resource Center to grant a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2018-2020 tax years on parcel 16-06-428-003-0000 (recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on April 20, 2023, considered a request to grant a property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2018-2020 tax years on the above-mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

The Claimant acquired the property on March 14, 2018 and filed an application for exemption on January 14, 2022. The Board of Equalization granted the charitable exemption for the 2021 tax year and referred the prior tax years to the Property Tax Committee for review.

Based on the available evidence, the Property Tax Committee recommends the request for a property tax exemption as a charitable organization be granted for the 2018-2020 tax years. The taxes for these years remain unpaid, so an abatement of \$23,528.28 is appropriate, with the Treasurer's office to determine the final amount to be abated, with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued.
