The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on June 24, 2021, considered an application for 2020 active duty exemption due to the sale of the property or other change in ownership, after the lien date. The Committee recommends that the following:

Deny	Active Duty Exemption

Active Duty Exemption Tax Relief has been denied due to the following: Insufficient evidence submitted to determine if 200 days of active duty military service outside Utah in a continuous 365-day period were completed in 2019. Refer to Utah Code 29-2-1901. If you feel the County has improperly denied your request for Active Duty Exemption Tax Relief, you may appeal to the Utah State Tax Commission. The appeal must be filed within 30 days of this notification. The appeal should be filed with Council-Tax Administration, who will forward the appeal to the State Tax Commission.
