Re: The recertification of the Granite Community Council

Dear County Council Members,

The new Community Council ordinance decertifies all existing community councils in unincorporated Salt Lake County and requires that each community council apply to be recertified. Accordingly, with this letter, the Granite Community Council hereby requests that the Salt Lake County Council certifies the Granite Community Council as a recognized community council under the ordinances and policies of Salt Lake County and that the Granite Community Council be granted all rights and privileges available to it from the County.

The new ordinance lists specific requirements for certification. This letter, along with the attached documents include all of the required information. A list of the attached documents include:

- 1. A Request for Certification, that (1) lists the requirements from the ordinance and (2) the response and information of how the GCC meets the requirements.
- 2. Documents verifying the non-profit tax status of the Granite Community Council as required by ordinance.
 - A printout from the Utah Department of Corporations showing the GCC is registered and active as a Utah Non-Profit Corporation.
 - A copy of the original GCC Articles of Incorporation (May 24, 2013)
 - A copy of the original Granite Civic Committee Charter (January 11, 1945)
 - A copy of the minutes from the organizing meeting of the Granite Civic Committee (January 11, 1945)
- 3. A map showing the boundaries of the Granite Community Council prepared by the Salt Lake County Surveyor.

4. A copy of the current bylaws of the Granite Community Council as required by the ordinance.

With the new certification the GCC respectfully requests the following.

- That the Granite Community Council be certified with the same boundaries that existed prior to decertification.
- That Salt Lake County recognize the prior elections of the Granite Community Council and the prior elected officers and council members that existed prior to the decertification.
- That Salt Lake County recognize, approve, and fund the Granite Community Council 2023 budget that was approved by the Salt Lake County Council prior to decertification on Tuesday February 28, 2023.

We thank you for your consideration of this request and ask that you act on it at your earliest convenience. We are available as needed to answer questions and provide additional information.
