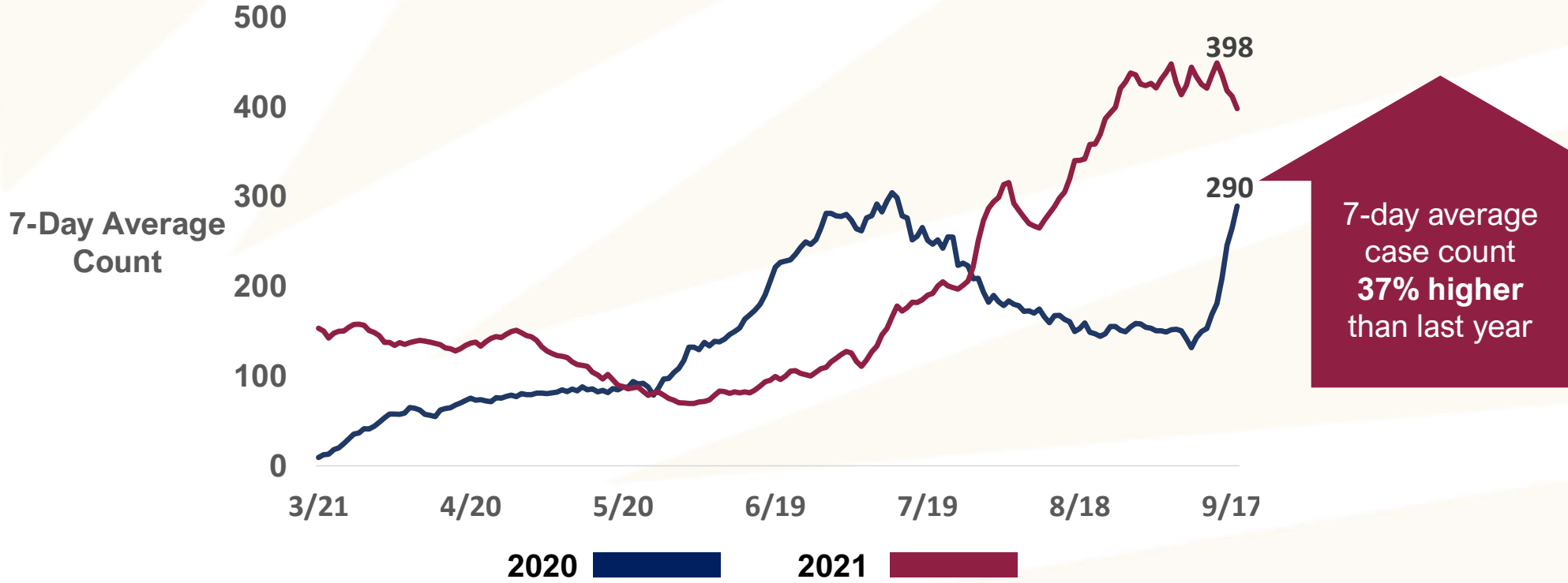

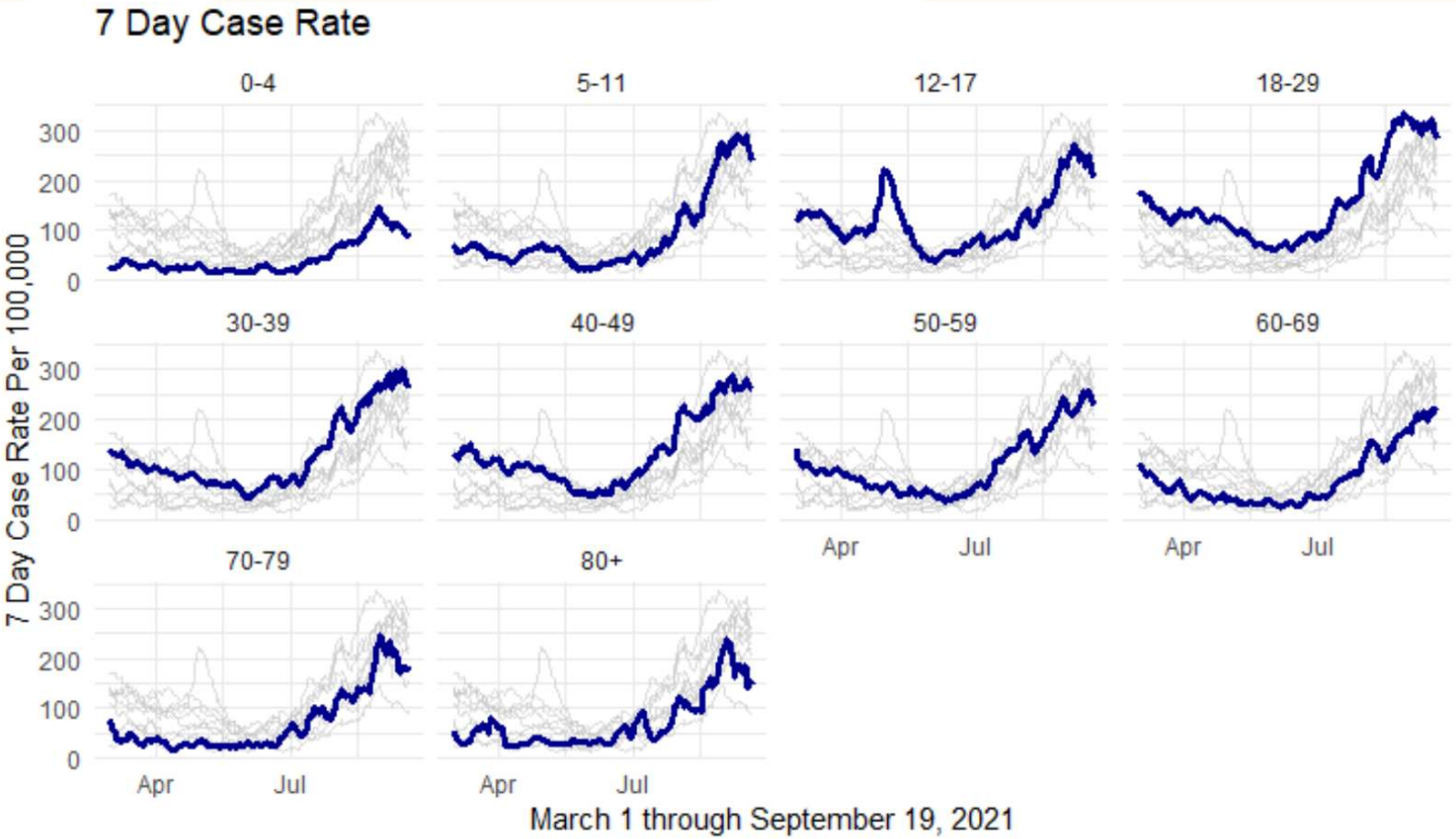

School-Aged Cases Continue to Rise



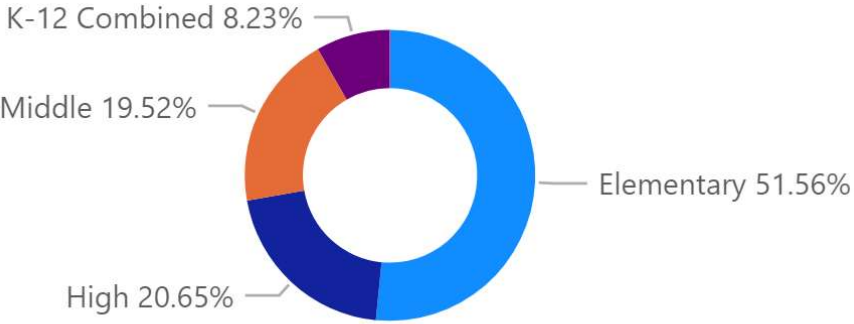

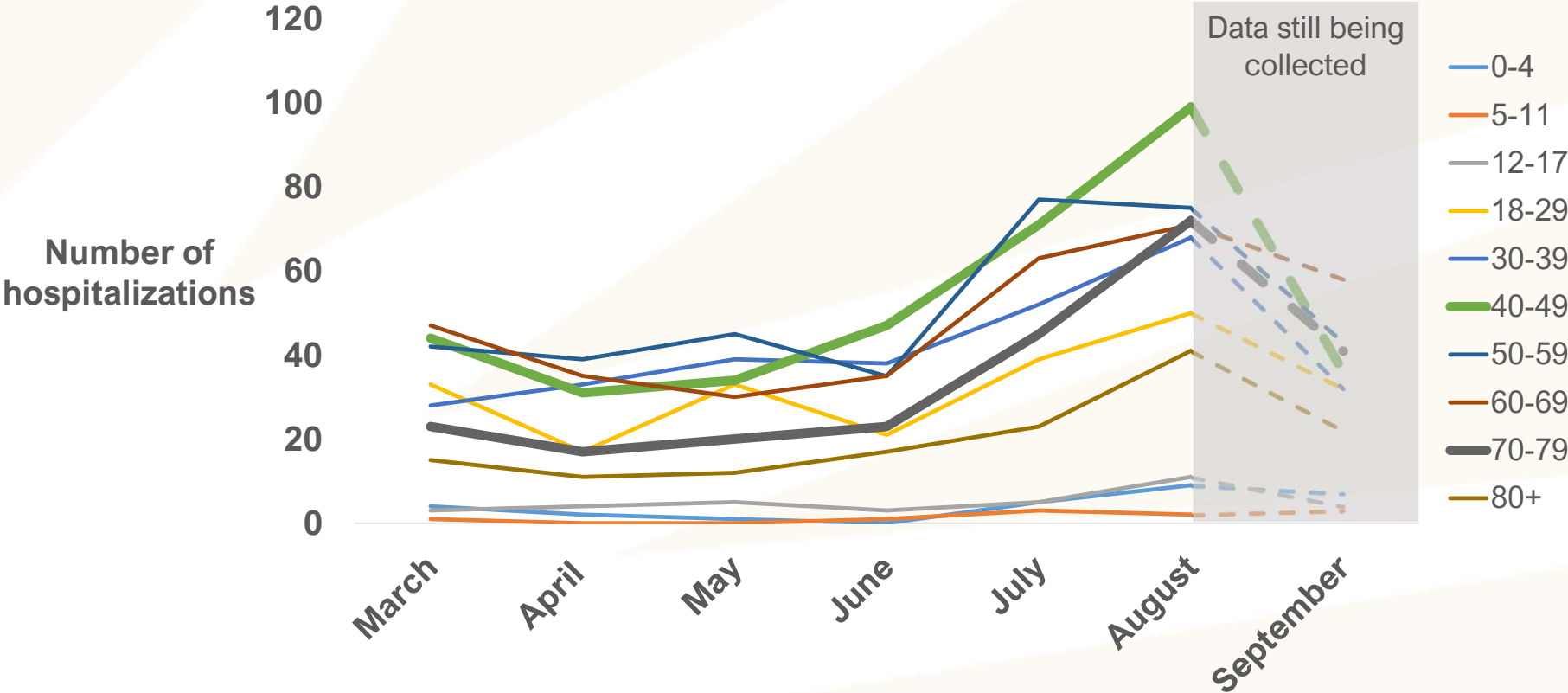

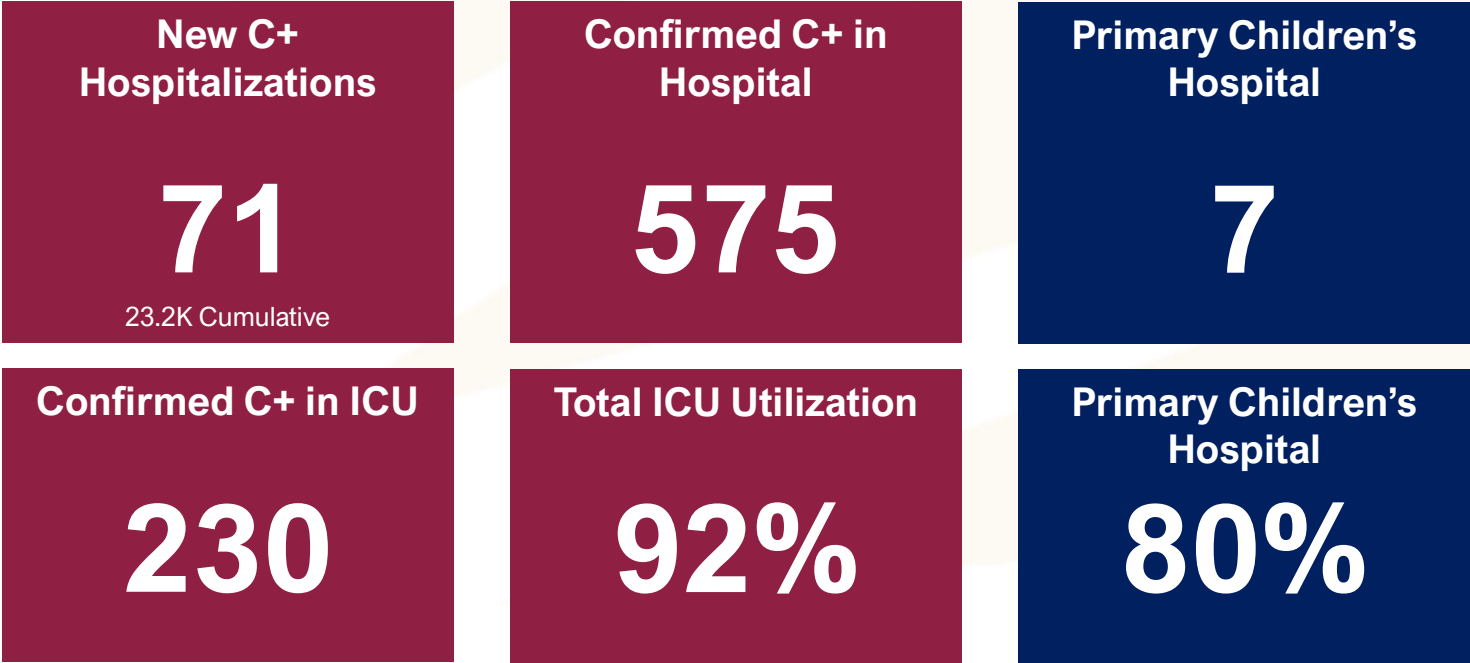

Number of Hospitalizations, By Age Group, March – September, 2021

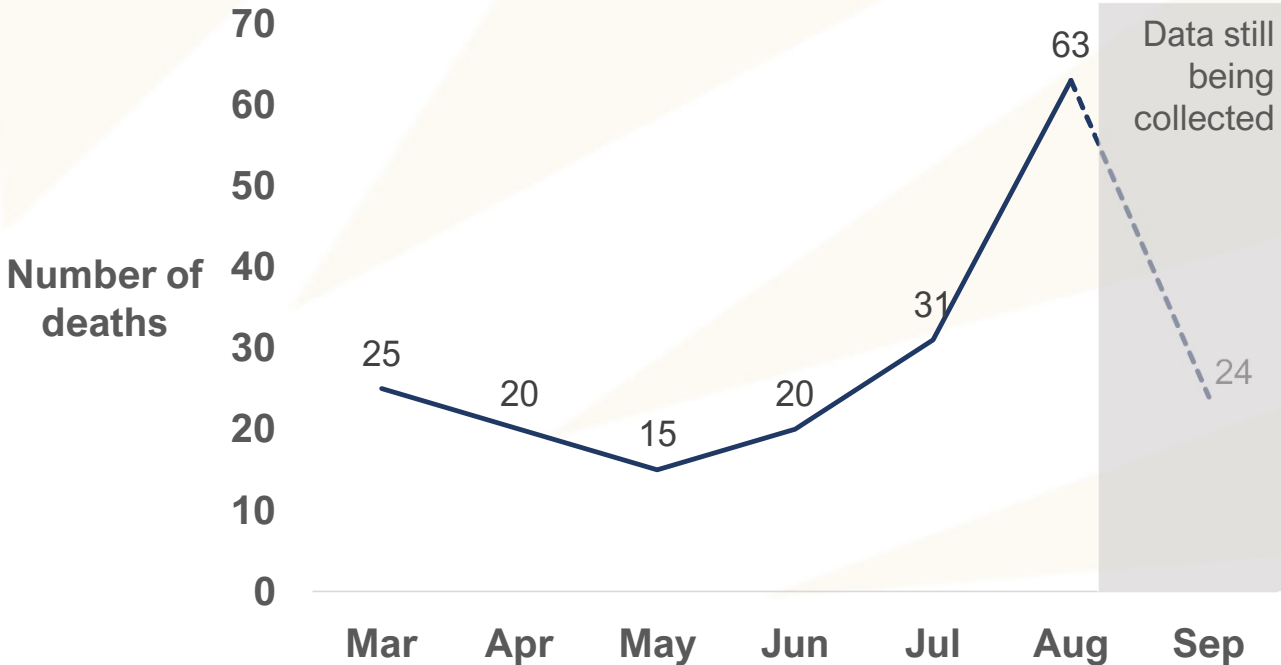


Salt Lake County ICUs Are At Capacity Today



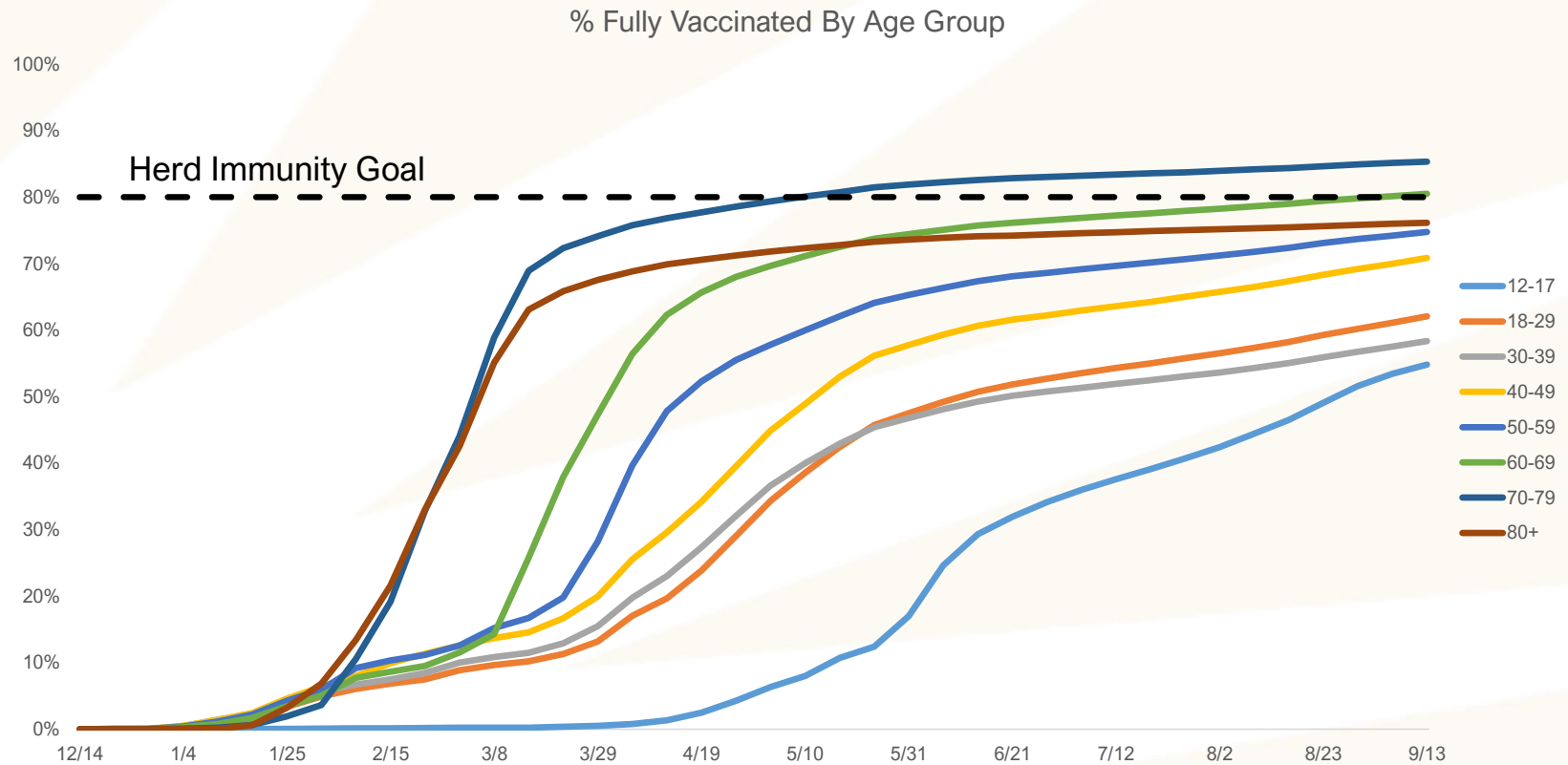
COVID-19 Deaths On The Rise Since Delta

Number of COVID-19 Deaths, March – September, 2021



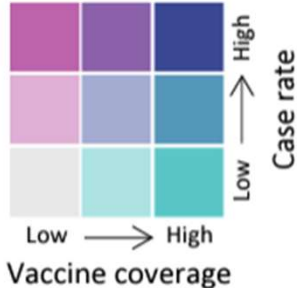

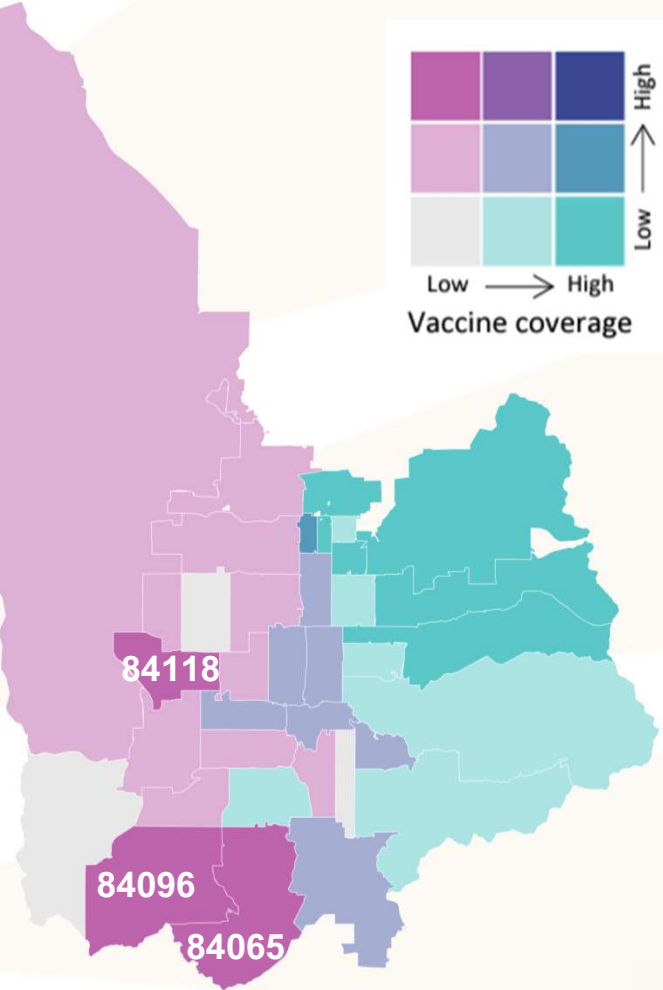


County's Southwest Corner Continues to Drive Cases
