Dear Honorable County Council Chair DeBry:

On behalf of the Tier I Advisory Board, I respectfully request that the Salt Lake County Council review and finalize the attached recommendations for Zoo, Arts and Parks Tier I and Zoological funding for 2022.

Twenty-two (22) organizations applied for Tier I funding and three organizations applied for Zoological funding. Per state statute, the Tier I category is limited to fund twenty-two (22) organizations and the Zoological category is limited to fund three organizations (3). Therefore, all applications have been reviewed and are being recommended for Zoo, Arts and Parks Tier I and Zoological funding.

Funding allocations are based on state statute. The Tier I category is distributed by percentage of the organization's three-year average of qualifying expenditures. The Zoological category is allocated by fixed percentages per Utah State Statute.

Thank you for your consideration of this request and we look forward to discussing these recommendations with the Salt Lake County Council.
