## SALT LAKE COUNTY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE, AMENDING TITLE 19, ENTITLED "ZONING" OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, 2001, BY RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN SALT LAKE COUNTY FROM THE A-2 ZONE (AGRICULTURE) TO THE A-1 ZONE (AGRICULTURE).

The Salt Lake County Council of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 19.06.020, Zoning Maps of Salt Lake County Code of Ordinances, 2001, is hereby amended, as follows:

The property described in Application #REZ2023-000944 filed by Adam Von Maack and located at approximately 3198 North 2200 West within Salt Lake County, is hereby reclassified from the A-2 Zone (Agriculture) to A-1 Zone (Agriculture), said property being described as follows:
