Summary:

**Location** - Ice Skating Facility of the Salt Lake City Sports Complex

**Concept** - Create dedicated areas specifically for the figure skating community.

**Areas Impacted** - Current concession room and common area outside the concession room and rink.

**Renovation Plan** - 1) convert common space into a separate lounge area and 2) convert concession room in a dressing room for figure skaters.

**Time Frame** - Thursday, May 19 - Tuesday June 14, 2022 (*tentative dates*).



Elements:

- Build decorative wall to create a separate lounge area specific to the figure skater, parents, and trainers

- Sofas, chairs, and tables to relax while waiting for skaters or attend to work in between ice times
- Monitor to watch all performances
- Figure skating themed décor and inspirational wall art (e.g., autographed skates)


