**Camp HOPE America** - Utah: Helping youth impacted by trauma create a brighter future by creating pathways to hope and healing.


Children's Justice Center (CJC): Provide a comfortable, neutral, child-friendly atmosphere for children to receive coordinated services during the child abuse investigative process.

  - Connection to community resources



# Children's Justice Center (CJC)




12 Positions Serving Two Locations
