ORDINANCE NO. _____, 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF SALT LAKE COUNTY,
UTAH, AMENDING SECTION 2.97.010 OF THE SALT LAKE COUNTY CODE OF
ORDINANCES, 2001, ENTITLED “DEBT REVIEW COMMITTEE” REDUCING
MEMBERSHIP TO SEVEN

The County Legislative Body of Salt Lake County ordains as follows:

SECTION I. The amendments made herein are designated by underlining the new substituted words. Words being deleted are designated by brackets with a line drawn through said words.

SECTION II. Section 2.97.010, of the Salt Lake County Code of Ordinances, 2001 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.97.010 - Debt review committee created.

Salt Lake County hereby establishes a [~~n-eight~~] seven member committee to be known as the Debt Review Committee, which shall review all proposed debt issuance with a repayment schedule that extends beyond the current fiscal year.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication in a newspaper published and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
