
#### Court Events & Workloads

Attorney workload is largely impacted by Court Events

Court Events will occur for cases that were filed in the current year as well as past years.

Court Events are the tool by which a case is adjudicated and serves to address legal issues raised by the participants (Court, Prosecutors, Defense Counsel)

# Preparing for Court

#### Every Filed Case will go to Initial Appearance

#### Every Court Event requires preparation by the assigned Attorney in conjunction with staff

- Review Charging Document
- Review Reports & Evidence
- Gather/Request Additional Evidence & Information
- Prepare Plea Offer (if warranted)
- Contact & Meet with Victims/Witnesses
- Prepare/Serve Subpoenas
- Retain Experts (if necessary)
- Prepare & Refine Arguments

#### Some Court Events require more intensive preparation

• Jury Trials Evidentiary Hearings Sentencing Hearings

Preliminary Hearings
Motion Hearings/Oral Arguments
Restitution Hearings

Not Uncommon for Court Events to be held multiple times
