RE: Request by Shelter the Homeless, Inc. to grant a real property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2017-2020 tax years on parcels 08-36-403-034 and 08-36-403-042 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on November 18, 2021, considered a request to apply a real property tax exemption as a charitable organization for the 2017-2020 tax years on the above-mentioned parcels. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In April 2021, Deputy District Attorney Brad Johnson reviewed the application and determined that the property was being used exclusively for charitable purposes. In June 2021, the Board of Equalization granted a tax exemption for the 2021 tax year and referred the prior years to the Property Tax Committee for review.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for the 2017-2020 tax years. A refund in the amount of \$26,745.58 for parcel 08-36-403-034 and \$5,491.58 for parcel 08-36-403-042 is applicable along with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued. The Treasurer's office shall determine the final amount to be refunded.
