The Dimple Dell Regional Park Advisory Board was created in 1991 to make recommendations regarding the planning, development, use and protection of Dimple Dell Regional Park.

The Board is composed of up to fifteen (15) member who represent the population of the park and are made up of multi-users including hikers, bicyclists, equestrians, school groups, nature lovers, etc.

Board meets monthly on the second (2nd) Wednesday at the Dimple Dell Recreation Center (or online, if needed).

- 15 members
  - Representatives from a variety of backgrounds, ages and interests, evenly distributed between equestrian and non-equestrian park users
  - 10 current members
  - 1 Re-appointment (pending)
  - Four vacancies
- Term: Three years
  - Two-term limit
