Request by Lifeline Community Church to grant a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2018 tax year on parcel 21-31-326-009 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on February 20, 2020, considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2018 tax year on the above mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In November 2019, the District Attorney's office made the determination that the applicant qualified for a religious exemption beginning January 1, 2019. The request for the 2018 tax year was referred to the Property Tax Committee for consideration.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the Claimant's request be granted for a pro-rated exemption from the date of purchase of February 21, 2018 to December 31, 2018. A refund of \$2,978.86 is applicable with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued with the Treasurer's office to determine the final amount to be refunded.
