RE: Request by The Door Christian Church to grant a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2016-2018 tax years on parcel 14-30-204-003 (Recommend grant)

Council Members:

The Property Tax Committee, at a meeting on June 18, 2020, considered a request to apply a property tax exemption as a religious organization for the 2016-2018 tax year on the above mentioned parcel. The committee recommends the request be granted.

In April 2020, the Board of Equalization made the determination that the applicant qualified for a religious exemption beginning January 1, 2019. The request for the 2016-2018 tax year was referred to the Property Tax Committee for consideration.

Based on the available evidence, the Committee recommends the request be granted. An abatement of the 2016-2018 past due taxes is applicable with any necessary adjustments for penalty and/or interest paid or accrued with the Treasurer's office to determine the final amount to be abated.
