EFCFP160002	Willow Ck Chan Below 11150 S	\$ 434,345.00	\$ (434,345.00)	\$ -	This project is being canceled due to easement acquisition issues. Project design was significantly changed at property owners request, more than doubling the construction cost. Property owner requests were not flood control related improvements. While this area is in need of improvement, the land that floods is undeveloped, creating minimal flooding risk to developed property.
EFCFP170005	Sandy City Canal White City SD	\$ 117,054.00	\$ (43,655.00)	\$ 73,399.00	These funds are available because the scope of this project changed abruptly Fall 2017, due to political decisions made by the White City Metro Township Community Council.
EFCFP170010	Scott Pond Improv Mill Creek	\$ 141,193.00	\$ 78,000.00	\$ 219,193.00	This request is for additional funds needed to award this project, as bids that were received came in higher than anticipated. These funds are needed to bring the pond into compliance with State Dam Safety requirements, and to protect the citizens of Millcreek from possible overflow flooding from this Countywide Flood Control Facility.
EFCFP170014	Spencer Pond Tower Improvements	\$ 160,275.00	\$ 25,000.00	\$ 185,275.00	This request is for additional funds needed to award this project. This project is needed to improve the ability of Flood Control crews to safely access debris during high flows. These funds are needed to bring the pond into compliance with State Dam Safety requirements.
EFCFP180005 (NEW)	SW Canal Creek Study Update	\$ -	\$ 100,000.00	\$ 100,000.00	With increased development in the south west quadrant of the County, an update to the Southwest Canal and Creek Study is an urgent need. The current study is at the end of its projected future, and the area is developing differently than was previously planned. The Mayors of Herriman City and Riverton City have requested an update of this study to assist them in the planning and growth of their communities.
EFCFP180006 (NEW)	Rose Creek Riverton Interlocal	\$ -	\$ 275,000.00	\$ 275,000.00	Riverton City approached Salt Lake County Flood Control and requested a financial contribution to a creek capacity improvement project on Rose Creek between Mountain View Corridor and the Provo Reservoir Canal. This project is scheduled to be constructed this summer. SLCo Flood Control has future capital improvement projects planned for this section of creek. By partnering with Riverton on this Flood Control improvement project, the section of creek will be improved sooner than currently planned and the Flood Control funds will go farther in completing these needed improvements.
