Previous conferences have been hosted in UT Co and Davis Co with lower attendance. The Sandy location of the MAEC is much more convenient for most attendees.

Describe why the organization is requesting the fee waiver:

The MAEC is a fantastic venue for our biannual conference, however with rising costs (food, A/V, etc), we are not able to cover these without charging our partners higher registration fees. Waiving the room fees will allow us to keep fees lower than most conferences, thus allowing more participation. In addition, this event represents Utah's Driver Education Conference for the year, sharing lifesaving traffic safety information to around 500 driver education teachers. We are hoping for an estimated 800-900 attendees this year, and the MAEC really is the best location for that audience size.
