Dear Honorable Mayor Wilson:

The Zoo, Arts and Parks (ZAP) Tier II Advisory Board respectfully requests your consideration of their 2023 funding recommendations. During the 2023 application cycle, the ZAP Tier II program received 212 applications, with requests totaling over \$4.7 million dollars. Of these submissions, the Advisory Board is recommending 208 applicants for Tier II funding totaling \$3,415,184.

The ZAP awards are based on a competitive process and organizations that apply are not guaranteed funding. The Tier II Advisory Board has met the minimum 5% funding distribution threshold in all six County Council Districts. Of the 212 submitted, two applications were determined to be ineligible; and two applications were declined for funding this year but have been encouraged to apply in future cycles.

If revenues do not meet projections and are less than the total recommended, each awardee (see detail attached) would be decreased a prorated amount. If the funding is more than the recommended amount, the excess funds will placed in fund balance to be rolled over for the 2024 Tier II process and/or be used for Council approved initiatives.

Thank you for your consideration of this request and for your continued support of the Zoo, Arts and Parks program.
