
What is BMX?

BMX Racing is a type of bicycle racing which features BMX riders sharing a short single-lap circuit, with multiple banked corners, jumps and rollers.













BMX vs Cycling Participants

OVERVIEW

Priority I: Upgrade track to meet UCI Guidelines and repair existing critical track components

Priority 2: Upgrade grounds and existing structures

Priority 3: Upgrade parking lot and better secure facility

Total Cost \$425,000 - Rad Canyon has \$75000 to contribute as needed and business willing to donate time and labor.

PRIORITY 1:

UPGRADE TRACK TO MEET UCI GUIDELINES AND REPAIR EXISTING CRITICAL TRACK COMPONENTS (PAGE 2)

Estimated Cost: \$250,000

- Rebuild all turns and straightaways
- Plumbing/drainage under track
- Install retaining walls in staging area
- Resurface staging hill and surrounding area
- Install new staging shoots
- Lighting in staging area
- Permanent cover staging area

PRIORITY 2: UPGRADE GROUNDS AND EXISTING STRUCTURES

Estimated Cost: \$100,000

- Lighting and Sound system update
- Move announce stand/upgrade
- Moto Boards
- Exterior painting




