The Salt Lake Valley Law Enforcement Service Area (SLVLESA) requests to be on the Salt Lake County Council meeting agenda for October 15, 2019. At the meeting, SLVLESA will be asking the County Council to consider and take action on a proposed resolution approving a decision, if made by the SLVLESA Board of Trustees, to increase budgeted property tax revenues by 3% for calendar year 2020 resulting in a property tax levy that exceeds the certified tax rate.

Attached is a proposed resolution and a report on the purposes for the property tax increase. The proposed resolution has also been submitted to Deputy District Attorney Ralph Chamness for review since his office will need to approve the resolution as to form. The proposed resolution has also been sent to Mitchell Park, attorney for the County Council.

We anticipate that the discussion will take between 15 and 30 minutes. The presenter will be Frank Nakamura, the SLVLESA District Administrator and Legal Counsel. Because of the strict statutory timelines for a property tax increase, it is necessary that the Council take action on the proposed resolution at the October 15th meeting.
