All Levels of Certification need to be signed off by a Manager, Supervisor and Field Foreman	
LEVEL I CERTIFICATION Must be able to complete these operations/scenarios:	
	Must complete the Pre Job/ Daily check list for vactor truck and explain each portion that applies.
	Must be able to identify all grease points on the lubrication check list
	Hydro-excavate a hole with minimal disturbance around hole or pipe/object
	Hydro-excavate while throwing minimal debris on surrounding objects
	Clean pipe to 95-100% clean (pipes with bellies in them are impossible to get 100%)
	Clean catch basin with vacuum tube, and hand sprayer
	Change a leader hose
	Crimp a new hose end on Piranha hose after hose is damaged
	Replace piranha hose unsupervised after usable life is gone
