Agenda Item #1 Financial Adviser Update – Zion's Bank

Jon Bronson gave an update on the bond buyer index, municipal bond market rates and economic conditions. Jon Bronson updated the committee on the SEC's MCDC Initiative. Zion's and multiple underwriters have reviewed the County's continuing disclosures and do not have any concerns. Basel III's classification of municipal bonds as "non-liquid" may affect bond sale prices.

Agenda Item #2 Sales Tax Bonds: RFP or Bid
